PIPE LINES (OIL) STATISTICS

AUGUST, 1958

Deliveries of oil from Canadian pipe lines continued to decline, dropping 6.0 p.c. in August to 23,141,064 barrels from 24,607,743 recorded one year ago. This decline was due entirely to the reduced flow of exports which amounted to only 2,213,762 as against 4,507,400 in August last year. The daily average delivery of 714,228 barrels compares with 793,798 last year and 770,465 in July. Barrel miles, in millions, declined to 8,270 from 10,105 in August 1957, while the average length of haul fell to 245.1 miles from 281.4.

For the first eight months of the year total net deliveries from both gathering and trunk lines amounted to 181,880,363 barrels, as compared with 201,712,472 in the corresponding period last year. Provincial deliveries, in barrels were as follows (1957 data in brackets): British Columbia 21,417,431 (43,440,542); Alberta 11,160,932 (9,115,600); Saskatchewan 10,655,154 (11,999,034); Manitoba 58,940,543 (51,617,081); Ontario 28,022,628 (29,820,971); and Quebec 51,683,675 (55,719,244). Included in Manitoba deliveries were 51,909,678 barrels (44,658,278) transferred to the Lakehead Pipe Line Company at Gretna, the bulk of which moved through the United States destined to Ontario refineries. Exports via pipe line are shown in a footnote to table 4.

Gathering systems handled an average of 421,401 barrels per day in August, a decrease of 8.0 p.c. from the 458,112 barrels reported last year, and a 7.3 p.c. decrease from last month. Trunk line deliveries at 1,088,407 barrels per day were down 5.8 p.c. from the 1,155,166 barrels recorded in August 1957, and 2.3 p.c. below the 1,113,994 barrels handled in July.

Net receipts for the month decreased 10.0 p.c. to 22,747,623 barrels from 25,264,897 in the corresponding month last year. August receipts were comprised of 8,885,625 barrels of Alberta crude and 39,521 barrels of Alberta natural gasoline, 3,678,925 barrels of Saskatchewan crude, 485,108 barrels of Manitoba crude, 6,274,050 barrels of imported crude and 3,384,394 barrels of refinery products.

Employment and wages decreased in August, with 1,690 employees earning \$787,655, as against 1,792 employees earning \$836,162 last year.

Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company, Anglo-Ganadian Oils, Ltd. and Valley Pipe Line Company, Ltd. have been omitted. Data of the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.

The fluctuations which occur in Shippers and Carriers balances monthly are accounted for by each company in a "monthly oil balance" statement. The oil balances have been tabulated for all companies for August and are given herewith.

The Interprovincial Pipe Line Company operates some 1,600 miles of line in Canada from Edmonton to the International border near Gretna, Manitoba, along with 7 miles of 30 inch pipe coming into Canada across the St. Clair River at Sarnia. This short line was extended in the fall of 1957 to Clarkson, Ontario. The Sun Pipe Line Company also operates lines across the St. Clair River from the United States to Sarnia. Oil delivered at Sarnia and Clarkson via Interprovincial's line would be a duplication of oil already reported on the western section of the line. For this reason and because of the limited nature of their operations, oil carried by these short sections is not included in Canadian oil pipe line statistics. However, commencing with April this year the barrel mile performance of these sections has been included with the total barrel miles shown in tables five and six. A summary of oil delivered by these two lines at Sarnia and Clarkson follows:




