GAS PIPE LINE TRANSPORT

JULY, 1961

Net deliveries of natural gas through Canadian pipe lines totalled 25,473,326 Mcf. during July, up 40.8 per cent from the total of 18,092,390 Mcf. reported in July, 1960. Daily average sendout was 821,718 Mcf. as compared with 583,625 Mcf. Peak day deliveries, uncompensated(1), amounted to 1,166,771 Mcf. while the minimum day deliveries of 630,125 Mcf. were some 46.0 per cent less. Exports increased 55.8 per cent to 12,969,280 Mcf. from 8,324,211 Mcf. in the previous year. Net deliveries for the twelve month period ending July 31, 1961 were 359,702,639 Mcf.

Alberta continued to account for the highest share of provincial receipts, 68.2 per cent, while the greatest portion of deliveries, 34.1 per cent, was made in British Columbia.

Total Mcf. miles (not including Ontario Natural Gas Storage and Pipelines Ltd., calculations of which are not available due to the complexity of their operations) amounted to 26.8 billion or 611 million ton miles.

Total pipeline fuel amounted to 611,226 Mcf. during July while the line pack increased by 106,371 Mcf.

Gas volumes used in this report are given at a common base so that one cubic foot of gas contains 1,000 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at $60^{\circ}F$. One Mcf. equals 1,000 cubic feet.

The gas pipe line transport industry is defined as that industry which is engaged in the transportation of natural gas, by pipe line, from natural gas fields or processing plants to local distribution systems. Companies included in this industry obtain the bulk of their revenue from the sale of gas to distribution companies for resale. Those companies that derive most of their revenue from the sale of gas to final consumers are classified as being in the Gas Distribution Industry.

Monthly reports of "Sales of Manufactured and Natural Gas" include summary data of receipts and deliveries of natural gas by transmission and distribution systems combined.
