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

# OTTAWA - CANADA

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In March 1962, the gas utilities received from field gathering systems and processing plants 72.8 million Mcf. of natural gas, 50.5 million Mcf. of which was received by transport systems and 22.3 million Mcf. received directly by the distribution systems. In addition, some 2.9 million Mcf. of natural gas was received from storage. The total supply of gas utilities, 75.8 million Mcf. was 36.3 per cent higher than in March 1961. Of the total supply, 46.4 million Mcf. were sold to ultimate customers in Canada, an increase of 20.4 per cent, while exports amounted to 30.5 million Mcf., an increase of 93 per cent. The difference between gas supply and deliveries was accounted for by losses including cyclical billing adjustments, B.T.U. adjustments, line pack changes and small deliveries to storage. Transport systems delivered some 23.5 million Mcf. to distribution systems, an increase of 9.0 per cent from the previous year.

Line pack changes included changes in the transport systems as well as certain changes in the transmission lines of the distribution systems. The changes in line pack of the transport systems are given separately in table 3.

The transport systems which represent virtually all of the major "inter-city" movements of natural gas had traffic amounting to 45.2 billion commodity (Mcf.) miles compared with 37.1 billion for the same period last year. Ton miles for March 1962 totalled 1,031 million. The daily average deliveries of gas utilities amounted to 2.5 million Mcf./day.

Revenues for the natural gas utilities for the month was \$37,759,862. Manufactured and liquefied petroleum gases systems had revenues of \$225,924 for a combined total of \$37,985,786 for March 1962.

For the three month period January to March 1962, total net receipts totalled 217 million Mcf. compared with 157 million Mcf. last year and total net deliveries amounted to 233 million Mcf. compared with 166 million Mcf. for March 1961.
