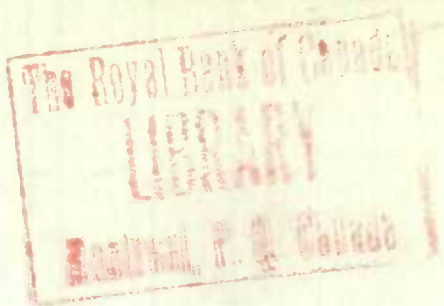

TELEGRAPH AND CABLE STATISTICS

STATISTIQUE DES TÉLÉGRAPHES ET CÂBLES

1960

Canadian telegraph and cable companies established another record high net for income of \$11,761,141 in 1960, increasing 40.2 per cent over the 1959 high of \$8,391,094. Operating revenues increased 10.5 per cent to \$58,546,167 from \$52,962,913 in 1959 and operating expenses rose 4.7 per cent to \$45,538,063 from \$43,511,666, resulting in a net operating revenue of \$13,008,104, 37.6 per cent above the 1959 record high of \$9,451,247. The increase on revenues from the leaseing of circuits, and other facilities, broadcasting and telephone service, and cables, more than offset a decline from transmission of messages.

Total cost of property and equipment advanced 17.8 per cent to \$267,379,018 from \$226,914,034 with seven out of nine companies reporting net increases over the previous year. The Canadian National Telegraph Company and the Canadian Overseas Telecommunication Corporation registered the largest gains of \$25,675,920 and \$11,687,979 respectively. The Canadian Pacific Railway Company rose \$2,686,957 and the Eastern Telephone and Telegraph Company showed an increase of \$369,889. New construction for year 1960 was valued at \$41,565,689 and the cost of alteration and maintenance at \$6,207,491. The total of \$47,773,180 expended on property and equipment during 1960 represents a 38.5 per cent increase over the \$34,485,239^r reported in 1959.

The number of telegrams transmitted in 1960 continued to decline to a low of 15,546,292 marking a decrease of 5.4 per cent from 16,390,997 in 1959. Telegrams sent numbered 13,726,090, down 5.2 per cent from the previous year while messages received from the United States totalled 1,820,202, down 7.3 per cent. The number of cablegrams transmitted, however, rose to a new high of 2,663,598 up 2.3 per cent above the total of 2,602,974 registered in 1959 while money transfers showed a decline of 1.8 per cent to \$25,134,534 from \$25,589,067 one year earlier.

Total pole line mileage increased 624 miles to 48,159 and wire mileage rose 23,765 miles to 510,640 during 1960. Major changes in the wire mileage were wire in cable increases of 21,855

Le revenu net des sociétés canadiennes de télégraphes et câbles a touché le nouveau haut de \$11,761,141 en 1960, en augmentation de 40.2 p. 100 sur le chiffre sans précédent de \$8,391,094 en 1959. Les recettes d'exploitation ont augmenté de 10.5 p. 100 ou de \$52,962,913 qu'elles étaient en 1959 à \$58,546,167 en 1960. Les frais d'exploitation ont augmenté de 4.7 p. 100 ou de \$43,511,666 à \$45,538,063, ce qui laisse des recettes nettes d'exploitation de \$13,008,104 ou 37 p. 100 de plus que le chiffre sans précédent de \$9,451,247 atteint en 1959. L'augmentation des recettes provenant de la location de circuits et autres installations, des services de transmission radiophonique et téléphonique et des messages par câbles ont plus que contrebalancé la diminution des recettes provenant de la transmission de messages.

Le coût total de la propriété et de l'outillage a augmenté de 17.8 p. 100, soit de \$226,914,034 à \$267,379,018 et sept de neuf sociétés ont signalé des augmentations sur un an plus tôt. Les plus fortes augmentations ont été enregistrées par les Télégraphes du National-Canadien et la Société des Télécommunications transmarines, soit \$25,675,920 et \$11,687,979 respectivement. Pour le Pacifique-Canadien le coût s'est accru de \$2,686,957 et pour la *Eastern Telephone and Telegraph Company*, de \$369,889. Au cours de 1960, les nouvelles constructions ont été évaluées à \$41,565,689 et le coût des réparations et de l'entretien, à \$6,207,491. Les dépenses totales de l'année en propriétés et outillage se sont accrues de 38.5 p. 100 sur celles de 1959 (\$47,773,180 contre \$34,485,239^r).

Le nombre de télégrammes transmis a de nouveau baissé, en 1960, et cette fois au bas niveau de 15,546,292, soit de 5.4 p. 100 sur les 16,390,997 de 1959. Les télégrammes expédiés (13,726,090) ont diminué de 5.2 p. 100 sur un an plus tôt et les dépêches reçues des États-Unis (1,820,202), de 7.3 p. 100. Les transmissions de câblogrammes, toutefois, ont augmenté à un nouveau sommet (2,663,598), soit de 2.3 p. 100 sur les 2,602,974 de 1959; par contre, la somme des transferts d'argent par télégraphe a diminué de 1.8 p. 100, soit à \$25,134,534 au regard de \$25,589,067 un an auparavant.

La longueur totale des lignes sur poteaux s'est accrue de 624 milles, soit à 48,159 milles et la longueur du fil, de 23,765 milles, soit à 510,640, en 1960. Les principales augmentations ont été enregis-

miles by the Canadian National Telegraph Company, 1,893 miles by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company and 29 miles by the Ontario Northland Railway Company. The Western Union Telegraph Company reported a decrease of 12 miles from 1959.

Offices maintained for receiving and sending messages totalled 5,610, an increase of 131 over the 1959 total of 5,479. Employees engaged in the industry numbered 10,279, down 307 from 10,586 and salaries and wages also declined to \$39,557,822 from \$40,059,303. The average annual salary rose to \$3,848, from \$3,784, an increase of 1.7 per cent over 1959.

Le nombre des employés s'est élevé à 10,279, diminution de 307 sur les 10,586 de 1959 et la rémunération a aussi diminué de \$40,059,303 à \$39,557,822. Toutefois, la rémunération annuelle moyenne s'est accrue de \$3,784 à \$3,848, soit une augmentation de 1.7 p. 100 sur celle de 1959.

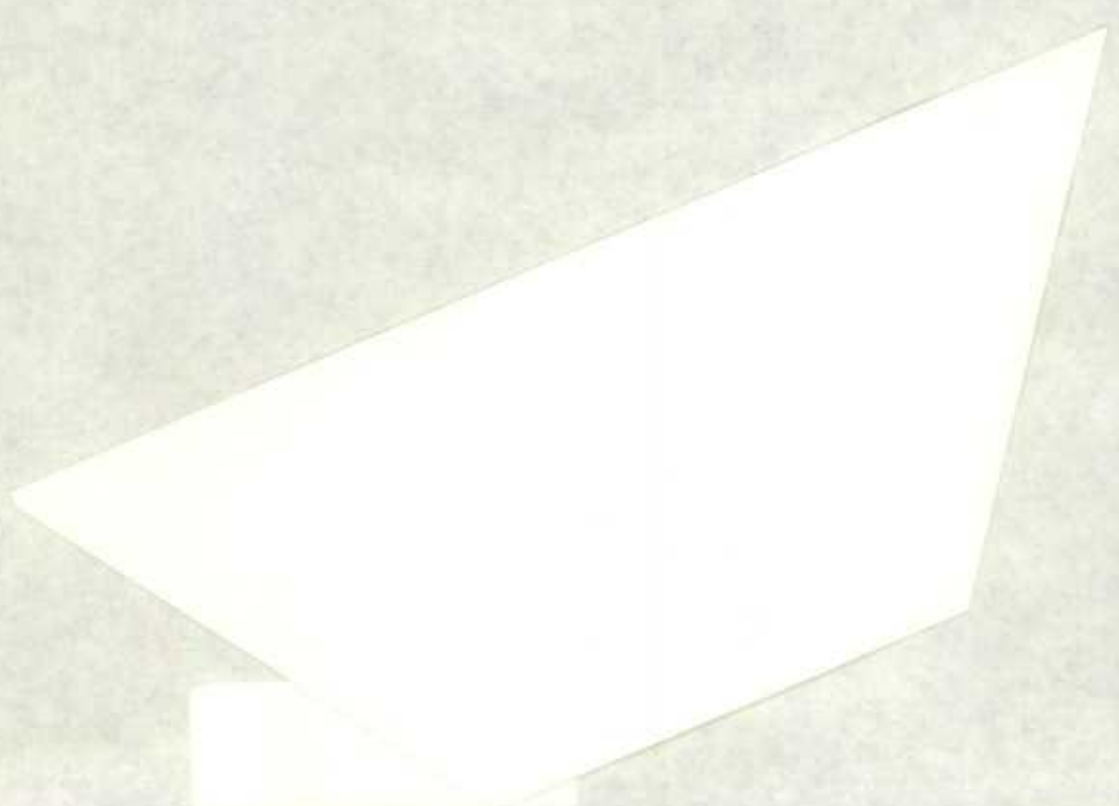
