Preliminary(1) Report on Coal Production

November 1969

Preliminary data indicate that coal production for the month of November amounted to 991,956 tons, a decrease of 3.8% from the 1968 preliminary production figure of 1,031,625 tons. Landed imports were 1,921,799 tons compared with 2,008,674 tons for the same period last year.
