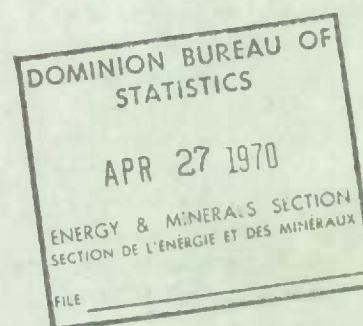

Preliminary(1) Report on Coal Production
March 1970

Preliminary data indicate that coal production for the month of March 1970 amounted to 1,200,477 tons, an increase of 17.1% from the March 1969 preliminary production figure of 1,025,523 tons. Landed imports were 117,350 tons compared with 86,871 tons for the same period last year.
