Preliminary (1) Report on Coal Production

October 1970

Preliminary data indicate that coal production for the month of October 1970 amounted to 1,649,618 tons, an increase of 53.6% from the October 1969 preliminary production figure of 1,074,261<sup>r</sup> tons. Landed imports were 2,048,374 tons compared with 1,892,414<sup>r</sup> tons for the same period last year.
