

BANK DEBITS TO INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNTS, OCTOBER, 1934.

The amount of cheques cashed against individual accounts by the branch banks in the 32 clearing centres moved up in October to a relatively high point greater than in the same month of any other year since 1930. The gain over September, after seasonal adjustment, was 7.2 p.c. The total for October, 1933 was exceeded by no less than 20.8 p.c. During the first ten months of 1934, the cumulative total was 8.4 p.c. greater than in the same period of last year.

Comparison with October, 1933.

Bank debits were \$3,409,900,000 in October compared with \$2,823,400,000 in the same month of last year. The gain of 20.8 p.c. represents a considerably higher level of business and financial activity.

Gains were shown in Saint John and Moncton, the total for the Maritime Provinces being up 7.8 p.c. Montreal and Quebec city showed increases in October over the same month of last year, the gain in the former amounting to 23.7 p.c. The net result for the province was a gain of 24.7 p.c.

With one exception gains were general among the thirteen centres in Ontario. The total in Toronto was up 9.5 p.c., while the province showed an increase of 16.6 p.c.

Each of the ten centres in the Prairie Provinces recorded gains in this comparison except Brandon. The increase in Winnipeg was 29 p.c., a gain of 26.8 p.c. being shown in the three provinces.

Gains were general in the three centres of British Columbia, the total for the province being up 15 p.c. The gain in Vancouver was nearly 9 p.c.

Comparison with September after seasonal adjustment

The gain in the Dominion total during October over the preceding month after seasonal adjustment was 7.2 p.c. Quebec, Ontario and British Columbia participated in the advance. The gain in the Maritime Provinces was less than normal for the season. The province of Quebec was up 7.3 p.c., Montreal recording a gain of 6.8 p.c. The gain in Ontario was 13.7 p.c., with Toronto showing an increase of 11.3 p.c.

The adjusted decline in the Prairie Provinces was 11.7 p.c. and Winnipeg did not show the normal increase for the season. The gain in Vancouver was 5.2 p.c., the net result for the province being an increase of 11.3 p.c.

Comparison with the Total for the first 10 months of 1933.

Each of the five economic areas except the Prairie Provinces showed gains in the first ten months of 1934 over the same period of the preceding year. The gain in the Dominion total was 8.4 p.c., the amount being \$26,734,000,000 compared with \$24,652,000,000 in the first ten months of 1933.

The cumulative total in the Maritime provinces was 11.4 p.c. greater, Moncton showing a gain of 23.4 p.c. Montreal recorded an increase in this comparison resulting in a gain of 10.6 p.c. in the province of Quebec.


Gains were nearly general in the 13 centres of Ontario, the total for the province being up 13 p.c. The gain in Toronto was 10.7 p.c. The decline in the Prairie Provinces at 3.5 p.c. was mainly due to the drop in Winnipeg. Gains were general in the three centres of British Columbia, the increase for the province being 8.9 p.c.

Turnover of Bank Deposits

The ratio of bank debits to deposits in Canada was 179.4 p.c. in October compared with 151.5 p.c. in the same month of last year. The increase in bank deposits during the interval was 2 p.c. while debits were up 20.8 p.c.


Comparison with Six Economic Factors

The index of bank debits after seasonal adjustment was 117.3 in October compared with 109.4 in the preceding month. Wholesale prices were at a lower level, the index being 71.4 compared with 72.0. Common stocks prices advanced to the highest point since June last, the index being 85.2 compared with 83.8 in September. Trading was more active on the Montreal stock exchange, the index being 45.4 compared with 32.9.




