

BANK DEBITS TO INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNTS, SEPTEMBER, 1934.

The amount of cheques cashed against individual accounts by the branch banks of the 32 clearing centres of Canada was five per cent greater in September than in the same month of last year. Advances were shown in each of the five economic areas except Quebec and British Columbia. Gains were predominant in the Maritimes, Ontario and the Prairie Provinces. Only three centres in Ontario failed to show a gain over September, 1933. Eight centres out of the ten in the Prairie Provinces showed greater financial transfers than in the same month of last year.

Increases were general in the three centres of the Maritime Provinces, the net result being a gain of 6 p.c. in the total for the area. The city of Quebec reported a greater amount of cheque payments, while the total in Montreal was down 3 p.c. The provincial total for Quebec showed a decline of 2.7 p.c., the total in September having been \$705,000,000.

The gain in Toronto was 8.9 p.c., while the total for Ontario was up 12.3 p.c. The increase in Ottawa was from \$81,000,000 to \$132,000,000. Despite the decline of one half of one per cent in Winnipeg, a gain of 3.3 p.c. was shown in the total for the Prairie Provinces. Debits showed a decline in the three centres of British Columbia.

The Dominion total was \$2,581,000,000 compared with \$2,457,000,000 in the same month of last year.

Comparison with the First Nine Months of 1933

Cheques cashed in the first nine months of 1934 showed a gain of nearly 7 p.c. over the same period of last year. The total was \$23,324,000,000 compared with \$21,829,000,000 in the first nine months of 1933. Each of the economic areas except the Prairie Provinces showed a gain in this comparison. The increase in the Maritime Provinces was nearly 12 p.c., each of the three centres participating in the advance. The gain in Quebec was due to the improved showing in Montreal, where the gain was 10 p.c. The gain for Quebec province was 8.8 p.c.

Each of the thirteen centres in Ontario except Sarnia reached a higher level, the gain in Toronto being nearly 11 p.c. The increase in Ontario was \$1,165,000,000 or 12.5 p.c. Debits in the Prairie Provinces were 7.2 p.c. less than in the first nine months of 1933, the decline in Winnipeg being 9.7 p.c.

Owing to the gain of 9.8 p.c. and 8.2 p.c. in Vancouver and New Westminster, respectively, the cumulative total for British Columbia was up 8.1 p.c.

Comparison with August after Seasonal Adjustment

Quebec and the Prairie Provinces showed in September seasonally adjusted gains over the preceding month. The decline in the Maritime Provinces was 5.8 p.c. Gains of 3.2 p.c. and 3.4 p.c. were shown in Montreal and the province of Quebec, respectively. The adjusted decline in Ontario was 2.9 p.c., Toronto showing a drop of 3.2 p.c. The comparison was favourable in the Prairie Provinces. The total for the area showed a gain of 6 p.c., while Winnipeg gained 3.7 p.c. The decline in British Columbia, after seasonal adjustment, was 11.7 p.c.

Turnover of Bank Deposits

The turnover of bank deposits was 1.38 in September compared with 1.32 in the same month of last year. During the interval bank deposits were up about 1 p.c., while debits showed a gain of 5 p.c.

Comparison with Other Factors

The index of bank debits, after seasonal adjustment, was 109.4 in September, compared with 112.4 in August. The index of the physical volume of business was 97.1 compared with 99.0. Employment in manufacturing plants remained unchanged at the first of October, the index being 91.9, the same as at September 1. Wholesale prices averaged slightly lower in September than in August, the index dropping from 72.3 to 72.0. The index of common stock prices was unchanged at 83.8, speculative trading being at a lower level.


