## CHEQUSS CASHED KGAINST INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNTS，JANUARY，19440

Cheques cashod in the clearing centres rose $15.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$ ．in the first month of the yoar over january，1943。 The total was $\$ 4,512$ million comparod with ncarly $\$ 3$ ， 900 million in the same montin last yenr．The higher level of cconomic activity and a slight advanco in wholesale prices was mainly instrumental in raising the amount of cheque pay－ monts．

Increases were shown in each of the five economic areas，the advances in the wostern provinces being of greater proportions than in the East．Tho total for the Mnritime Provinces was $\$ 96,8$ million against $\$ 83.8$ million，a gain of 15.5 p．ce Active business conditions in the Montreal district were indicatod by a considerable increase in bank dobits，the total rising from $\$ 1.025$ million to ${ }^{(12} 199 \mathrm{million}$ ．The total for the Provinoe of Quebec rosc 16.4 p．O．，the payments in January having been $\$ 1,347 \mathrm{mil}$－ lion．Ten of the fourteen centres in Ontario rocordod advances，the aggregate having boen 308 p．o．greatir，The total for Jnuary was $\$ 1,947 \mathrm{million}$ ，$\Lambda$ total of $\$ 1,098$ million was rocorded in Toronto while the incroase in Ottawa was from $\$ 437 \mathrm{million}$ to \＄486 million。

Each of the ten contres in the throo Prairic Provinces rocordod gains in Jan－ uaryo The total was $\$ 812$ million，a gain of noarly 49 p．c．The rise in Winnipeg was from $\$ 316$ million to $\$ 471$ million，British Columbia made an excellent showing in this connection，the total having been $\$ 310$ million against $\$ 238$ million in danuary last year， an increase of 30.5 p．o．Gains were shown in oach of the three clearing centros，tho total for Vanoouver rising from $\$ i 93$ million to $\$ 260$ milliono
Comparison with Decembor after Sensonal Adjustmonto
After seasonal adjustment，dobits in January wero 20.8 p．c．above the preced－ ing month．Gains wero genoral in the five economic areas in this comparison．The in－ cruase in the Maritime provinces after tho usual adjustmont vas 13.6 p．00 a gain of 26.3 p．c．was rocordod in Montreai，while the aggregato in the Provinco of Quoboc was 29,3 p．cogroater，After soasonal adjustment，cheques cashod in Winnipeg rocordod a gain of $36 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{Co}_{0}$ ，the total in vanuary havine boon $\$ 471$ million。

Advancos of 2504 p .0 o and 24.6 p .0 ．woro shown in Vancouvor and in tho aggro－ gate for British Columbia in ine same comparisono．The amount of chequos cashad in Jano uary is normally considorably less than in tho proceding montho While tho actual amounts shown for January in the prosent caso wro lower than in Docember，it is found that aftor sonsonal adjustment tho advancos wore fatrly general．
Oomparison with other Factors．
Estimating tho grand total of cineques cashed in Canada by adding $12 \frac{1}{2}$ p．c．to roportod totals in the 33 clearing centros，the indioated mount in danuary was $\$ 5,077$ million oomparod with $\$ 4,387$ million in tho samo month last yoar．Total doposits at tho boginning of the month wero $\$ 4,395$ million，an incroase of about $20 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{cos}_{\text {o }}$ over the same dato twelve months beforen Dividing the amount of cheques cashed by the deposits，wo find that tho turnover in sanuary was 1.16 timos comparod with $l_{0} 20$ times one yoar ago，

The circulating modia in the hands of the public roso from $\$ 681.5$ million in Jnury， 1943 to $\$ 849$ mellion in the month under roviow．$A$ considerablo gain was shown in the notes in the hande of the public as well as in tine subsidiary coin in circulation． Adding the oiroulating modia in the hands of tho public and the four main classes of bank doposits，tho money supply amountod to $\$ 5,244$ million comparod with $\$ 4,334$ million in Jnuary one yoar agoo

Cheques cashed against current accounts amountod to $\$ 4,337 \mathrm{mllif}$ ion in January comparod with $4_{4} 664$ million in the procoding month，while choques cashod against savings nocounts doollnod from $\$ \$ 86.5$ million to $\$ 175.1$ milliono Eaoh of the four classos of dew posits showod marked advances during the twelvo monthso Notice doposits rose from \＄1， 673 milion to $\$ L_{\epsilon} 948$ milifon whilo Dominion doposits wero $\$ 662$ milifon against $\$ 417$ riliona

Tho advanco in tho anount of choques cashod against individual accounts was not an isolated phenomenon in ünuary．The indox of bank debits rose from 148.3 to 171.6 during the twolve months．Markod gains wore shown in the indox of the physical． volum of business while significant increases occurred in omployment in manufacturing plents and in wholesale pricesc The index of the cost of living in January was 119。． against 117.1 in the same month last yoar．The index of common stock prices rose abort 7 p．oe in the same comparison．
