## CHDQUES OASHED AGAINST INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNTS，BSETKMRER， 1925

Cheques cashed in clearing centres recorded a gain of 7 par cent in September over the same month of 1944 ．The total wes $\$ 5.157$ million cumpared with $\$ 4.819$ miliion． Increases were shown in each of the five economic areas exccpt the Frairis Provinceso The greatest percentage increase was shown in the Maritises where the amount ross from $\$ 98$ million to $\$ 145$ million．The consequent incrsese was 47,5 per cont incruases were shown in Montreal and quebec，the net result boing that the piovincial total was 4．7 per cent greater．Cheques cashed amounted to $\$ 1,599$ milition agains ${ }^{4} 1,336$ adilion in September last year．

Bight of the 14 centres in Ontario fucoried increases，the toval having been $\$ 2,419$ million compared with $\$ 2,193$ million。 The inoroase $\pm 12$ Toronto was ivom $\$ 1,103$ million to $\$ 1,365$ miliion contributing greatly to the percentags increage of 10,3 per cent in the provincial total．Despite increases in six of the ion centres of the Prairie Provinces，the provincial total showed a recossion of 6,4 per cent．The cheques cashed amounted to $\$ 861$ million compared with \＄夕2l millione Tbe Winnipeg tobal recoded from $\$ 565$ million to $\$ 525$ million．Tha Britjish Corvertan total rose 23.3 per cent to $\$ 333 \mathrm{mlllion}$ ．Increases were shown in each of the throe clearing caritues，The total for Vancouver rose about $\$ 52$ million，the total in Soptember heving boen $\$ 269$ million．
COMPARISON WITH THE FIRST NINE MONTHS OF 19440
Chequee cashed in clearing centros were 9 pos cent getater in the inst nine months of 1945 than in the same period of last year．The toital was 847,970 million com． pared with $\$ 44,011$ m11110n，the indicated increase having veen more than $\$ \$ 3,959$ million． Increases were shown in each of the five economic araas except the Prairie Provinces． The increase in the Naritime Provinces was 17 por cent the total in the first nine months of the present year having been $\$ 1,095$ million．The incraase for the Piorince of Queboc was 8.3 per cent．The greatest absuluto aîvance of any of the uscnomic areas was shown in Ontario where the gain amounted to $\$ 2,616$ million．The toral whs $\$ 22,089$ million，an increase of 13.4 per cent．The recession in the Prairie Provinces was 1.6 per cent，the total in Soptember having been $\$ 8,158$ miliono Tho fotel for byitish Columbia rose 9.9 per cent，the advance having been from $\$ 2,761$ milition to $\$ 3.034$ million．

Cheques cashed in the 33 clearing centres were greates in the first nine months of the present year than in any other similar period．Whaci of the five economic areas except the Prairie Provinces reached a new maximum，Tha tetai for tho Prairie Provinces as Indicated above showed a recession of 1.6 per cent frow the sane pariod of 1914 when an historical maximum was recorded．Cheques cashed in tha clearing centres in the first nine months during the period from 1924 to 1945 aro shown by economic araas in table 5 on page 4.

The index of bank debits on the bese of 1935－1939 wes 19\％． 3 in Septomber against 184.3 in the same month of last year．The stenking in August was 184.7 ．In the same coraparison a considerable decline was shown in the index of the physical volume of business．The index of employment in manufacturing on the base of 1926 recedod from 219.9 at the beginning of August 1944 to 199.5 on the same gate of the present year．The increase in the index of common stock prices was from 85 in Soptomber last year to about 102.0 during the month under review．The index of the cust of living rose lol points to 119．9．The rise in the index of wholegele prices was from 102.3 to about 103.0 ．

## MONEY SUPPLY AND PAYMENTS

Money supply for the latest avallable period was $\$ 6,361$ mililon compared with $\$ 5,680$ million in the same month of last year．Money supply is cegerded es consisting of deposits subject to cheque and notes and subsidiary coin in the hands of the public， Deposits with the chartered banks and the Bank of Canede corisidered in this connection rose from $\$ 4,755$ million to $\$ 5,302$ million．The circilaiing media consisting of bank notes and subsidiary coin rose from $\$ 925$ million to $\$ 1,0595$ mijlion diring the carao period．Cash and cheque payments rose 4.8 per cent the total in tho iavest available month having been $\$ 6,761.4$ million
