Although bank debits in December showa a decline in comparison with December, 1927 , and also rith November last after seasonal adjustment, the total for last year was more inen 2. poc. in ercess of the asceegate for 1927. The total in 1928 was $\$ 43,47,000$, U00 a runuase of $\$ 7,370,700,000$ over ine preceding year. Wuch of this inc-ease mas explained by the greater activity in speculative trading, but the erpansion in efencral business was also an important factor in swelling the tota? Statistics of bank debits to individual accounts at the clearing house centres are published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics under an ariangement with the Canadian Bankers' A oiation

## Total for the Year 1928

The increasesin 1928 as compared with the preceding year were general throughout the five economic areas. The debits in Ontario during 1928 were $\$ 17,312,000,000$, an increase 0. I8. 3 p.c. Tho gain in Quebec province was nearly as great relatively, the tepal in 1928 being $\$ 14,913,000,000$. The Maritime Provinces showed an increase of $18.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. to $\$ 745,000,000$. The increases in Western Canada were what greater, the "airie Provinces showing the marked expansion of 20.6 p.c. The aggrceate in the thr provinces was $\$ 5,005,000,000$ compared with $\$ 5: 127,000,000$ in 1927. The expansion in British Columbia was well maintained, the increase in the yoarly total being $2 \overrightarrow{1} .5$ p.c.

In the Maritimes moderate increases were shown in Halifax and Moncton in December as compared with the tovais for December ig27, a decline being registered at Saint John. The debits of the three centres amounted to more than $\$ 69,000,000$, an increase of 9 p.e.

The debits of the province of Quebec showed a decline in December. This was owing to the recossion in Montroal and Quevec, as Sherbrooke showed an increase.

In the province of Onterio increases were recorded in all centres except Toronto: Ottawa and Peterbowough, the decline in the aggregate for the province being about 7.6 p.c.

Winnipeg was the only centre in the Prairie Provinces showing a docline, the net result being that the debits in the area were nearly maintained.

The debits of Vancouver shomod an incruase of $15 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$., while a decline was experienced in Victoria. Whe incruase ill the towal for the province was 11 p.c.
