sans: :ejits at $\$ 4,004,000,000$ were 15 p.c. greater in July than in the same month oi last year ad after seasonal adjustments nearly 13 p.c. greater than in June last. The gain in iinancial transfers during July was due to greater activity in the stock markets, as well as to the high level of indus ${ }^{\perp}$ rial production. Thile several industries showed recession in July, the general level of operations was decidedly favorable.

Statistics of bank debits are published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics mader an arrangement with the Canadian Sankers' Association.

## Banik Debits in the First Soven Months

Bank: debits in the first seven months of 1929 amounted to $\$ 26,839,000,000$, a gain of 9 p.c. over the same period of 1928 . Increases were shown in each of the ecoromic areas, the greatest absolute gain being shown in ontario, where the debits :mounting to more than $\$ 11,000,000,000$ were nearly 12 p.c. greater than in the first seven nontis of 1928 . The greatest percentage increase, amounting to 23 p.c.. Tas rhomn in Sritish Columbia. The Eain in the Maritime Provinces mas 8 p.c., while Queboc $\because 0 g^{i}$ stered an increase of $7.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. The debits in the Prairie Provinces rere more than saintaincd, the gain being about I p.c.

## Turnover of Bank Doposits

The turnover of bank denosits, denoting the ratio of bank debits to bank deposits, was more than $8 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. greater during the first seven months of 1929 than in the same period of 1928. In July the porcentage of debits to deposits was 187.5 compared 7 itin 159.5 in July, 1928. In the interval, deposits shoned a declino oi moro timn 2 n.c., While debits woro 15 p.c. greater.

Comparison bi Economic Aress, Fith July, 1028.
Bach of the three centros in the Naritime Provinces showed marled gains in T1l over the same month of 1928 , the net result being an increasc of 17 p.c.

The debits in Montreal at $\$ 1,474,000,000$..ere $33 \mathrm{p} \cdot \mathrm{c}$. greater than in July 1028, revived interest in speculation partly accounting for the high level of inencial transfers in the monti undor review. Debits in Quebec city and Sherbrooke stowed a dacline from last year, the aggregato for the orovince being 28.6 p.c. greater.

Each of the twolvo contres in Ontario showed incrouses except Peterborough, the gain in the aggregate for the province being 14 p.c. The debits of Toronto at $\$ 1,089,000,000$ mere 17.8 p.c. groater than in July, 1928.

Winnipeg and the branchos of the Woyburn Socurity Bank showed declines in July, whilo tho remaining contros in the Prairic Provincos registered gains. Tho total in the threc provinces wes $\$ 654,600,000$, a decline of $7.4 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$.

Gains Were general in the throe centres of British Columbia, the gain in Toncouvce being 20.5 p.c. The increase in the threo contres of British Columbia vas 17 n.c.
