## COMGRCLAL FAIIUROS IN CHMDA IN JKNARY, 1934.

The nunber of ascigmments undar tho Bankruptcy and Vinding Up Acts, as reported *. to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, showed in January, 1934, a substantinl dacline from the figure for January, 1933, whilo 1 anilitias of tho assignors also showod a notrole decline. Commercial failuxes nuriceraj 253 in innary, 1934, as compared with 216 in Jonuary, 1933, and 159 in Decamber, 1933. The linbilitios of the assignors, amounting to $\$ 2,009,188$, as comparod witin $\$ 2,344,772$ in Documber, 1933, showed a declino; whon comprod with $\$ 4,049,929$ in Jenurry, 1933, a considurabla äeclino is notod.

## COMRTRIAL FUIUURIS BY LRHAS

Peritime Provincasc- In the month under roview, thora woro 6 assigments in tho Moritime Provincos, is comperod with 11 in Doconbor, 1933, and 11 in Jinunry, 1933. A docidod decronso is notod in both comonrisons. The liabilitios of the assignors in jumanty 1934, wore bout $\$ 30,000$.

Quoboc.- Cormorciri foiluros in tho province of Quobec during Jonury, 1934. numberod 77 as aginst 82 in Ducorber, 1933, and 90 in Jonunry, 1933. A decruase is noted in both comparisons. The licbilitios more approximatoly $\$ 1,082,000$, of thoso 77 failures, 41 with liabilitios of about $\$ 500,000$ took pleco in the city of kiontroal.

Ontario.- In Ontario, the failmpos nuriberod 49 as agninat 42 in Documber, 1933, and 79 in Jnunry, 1933. A considernblo decreaso is notod in the latter more significant corparison. Iiabilitics aggrognted nout $\$ 645,000$. In tho city of Toronto, there mero 8 assigmonts with liabilities of nout $\$ 320,000$.

Pririo Provincos. - In tho throo Prairic Provinces filuros docroasod fron 20 in Documbr, 1933, to 15 in Jnnunry, 1934, and may bo cormared with 27 in January, 1933. The liabilitios mero spproximatuly $\$ 223,000$, principnlly in Alburtre Thore were 4 failuros in tho city of Wimipog $\begin{aligned} \\ \text { in } \\ \text { th } \\ \text { liabilitios of nbout } \$ 16,000 \text {. }\end{aligned}$

British Colutibin.- In British Columbin, corvarcicl falluros numbored 6 as compared with 4 in Decumber, 1933, and 9 in Jmunry, 1933. Tha liabilities moro approxiratoly $\$ 29,000$. Of those 6 failures, 2 with linbilitios of about $\$ 12,000$ were in the city of V -ncoupor.

Irodo. Trading ostrblishwats fumished tho largest nume of fniluros, 78 nssigning in Jinuary, 1934, as cormaroe. With 84 in Decanbar, 1933, and 121 in Jonunry, 1933. Of thoso concorns, 15 mero gonemi storos: G grocerios, 4 confoctionary, 6 fish and meat. 7 boots and shoos, 4 dry goons, 5 hardimaro, 2 jowelry, 2 conl and wood and 1 तrugs and chericicls.

Mnnufncturos.- Minufneturing ostebliahrents to the nuraber of 22 nssigned in
 is notod in both comprisons. The 22 incluturi 9 ongagec in tho mafacture of vogetablo foods, 3 in furs mel loathor, 3 in alothing, I in lumber and its monetured procucts, ond 1 in erugs and chartonts.

Agriculturo.- Lsgriculturists assising in Janunty, 1934, numberea 12 as cornpared Fith 9 in Docoribar, 1933. and. Ic in Johunry, 2533.

Servicoson In services, the faitures nutibored 20 as comperod with 20 in Decarbor, 1933, and 22 in Jonuary, 1933.

Miscollanoouss - Thore wore 7 fniluros in construction and 1 in finenco.
Statisticn Trblos, The cameroinl failuras in onch month from Jonury 1931 aro givon by provinoes in Tioble. rhtlc ?nble ? fumished statistics of comercial filures by branches of businoes by months fron Jomunry 1931 to Janunry 1934. Tho detallod figuros of falluros aring farung 1934 aro shown by provinces and branches of business in Table 3. The nssots and liabilitios of those eniling rluring Jnunry 1934 aro shom by provincos in Toblo 4.

## 4. COLLERCIAL FAILURES IN CANADA, BY PROVINCES, SHOYING ASSETS AND LIABILITIES, FOR JANUARY, 1934, WITH COMPARATIVE FIGURES FOR DECBMBER, 1933, AND PRECEDING <br> JANUARIES

(Prepared from the preliminary statements of affairs received from trustees)
