## COMERCJAL EAILURES TII THE CALENDAR YEAR 1937.

The cumulative total numer of commercial failures in Canada for 1937，as reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics under the provisions of the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts，was lower at 1,126 as compared with $1,198,1,314$ and 1,532 for 1936， 1935 and 1934 respectively，The defaulted liabilities for 1937 were $\$ 14,303,362$ as compared with $\$ 15,144,945, \$ 17,567,002$ and $\$ 23,598,260$ for 1936,1935 and 1934 respectively．Thus defaulted liabilities showed a decrease of nearly $\$ 1,000,000$ as compared with 1936．The Maritime Provinces，Ontario and the Prairie Provinces showed a decrease in number and the numbers for Quebec and British Columbia showed slight increases．

COMERCIAL FATLURES BY AREAS FOR 1937
COMPARED WITH 1936 and 1935．
Maritime Provinceso－In tho year under review，there were 46 assignments in the Maritime Provinces，as compared with 50 in 1936 and 69 in 1935，a reduction being noted in both comparisons．The liabilities in the year 193 ？were decidedly lower at $\$ 337,000$ as compared with $\$ 352,000$ in 1936 and $\$ 512,000$ in 1935 。

Quebec．－Conmercial failures in the Province of Quebec during 1937，numbered 623，as compared with 589 in 1936 and 632 in 1934 ．A decrease is noted in both compa－ risons．The liabilities aggregated $\$ 7,008,000$ ，and may be compared with $\$ 6,952,000$ in 1936 and $\$ 8,253,000$ for 1935 ．

Ontario．－In Ontario，the failures numbered 335 as compared with 384 in 1936 and 390 in 1935．The liabilities were about $\$ 5,126,000$ ．When compared with $\$ 6,244,000$ in 1936 and $\$ 5,053,000$ in 1935，a sharp decrease is noted in both comparisons．

Prairie Provinces。－In the three Prairie Provincess the failures in 1937 total－ led 82 and may be compared with 138 in 1936 and 195 in 1935．A striking decrease is noted in both comparisons．The liabilities of the assignors in 1937 were approximately $\$ 1,018,000$ and may be compared with $\$ 1,126,000$ in 1936 and $\$ 1,694,000$ in 1935 。

British Columbia．－In British Columbia，commercial failures in 1937 numbered 40，as against 37 in 1936 and 28 in 1935．The Iiabilities in 1937 aggregated $\$ 815,000$ ， and may be compared with $\$ 471,000$ in 1936 and $\$ 1,055,000$ in 1935 ．

## COMPARED WIMH PRECEDING YEARS

Commercial failures of trading establishments in 1937 numbered 584 as compared with 536 in 1936，and 594 in 1935．In manufactures，there were 182 failures in 1937 as compared with 191 failures in 1936 and 180 in 1935．Failures of agriculturists numbered 104 and may be compared with 123 in 1936 and 173 in 1935．A striking decrease is noted in these comparisons．More detailed information regarding the classes of business in which failures occurred in 1937 is given in Table 3．A summary of commercial failures in each year from 1924 to 1937 inclusive，is given by branches of business in Table 2.
