#### COMMERCIAL FAILURES IN CANADAA IN OCTOBER, 1941,

The total number of commercial failures in October, 1941, as reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, under the provisions of the Bankruptcy and Winding-Up Acts, was 71, as compared with 67 for September, 1941, and 70 for October, 1940. The defaulted liabilities for October, 1941, were \$548,892 as against \$492,126 for October, 1940, and \$541,173 for September, 1941.

#### COMMERCIAL FAILURES BY AREAS

Maritime Provinces. - In the month under review there were three commercial failures in the Maritime Provinces as compared with one in September, 1941, and no failures in October, 1940. The liabilities were approximately \$3,900.

Quebec. - Commercial failures in the Provinces of Quebec during October, 1941, numbered 43 as against 40 in September, 1941, and 44 in October, 1940. The liabilities were approximately \$298,000.

Ontario. - In Ontario, the failures numbered 21 as compared with 20 in September, 1941, and 26 in October, 1940. A decrease is shown when compared with the same month of last year. The liabilities were about \$184,000.

Prairie Provinces. - In the three Prairie Provinces, failures totalled four in October, 1941, and may be compared with six failures in September, 1941, and no failures in October, 1940. The liabilities were approximately \$55,000.

British Columbia. - In British Columbia, there were no commercial failures in October, 1941. No failures had been recorded in either September, 1941, or in October, 1940.

#### FAILURES BY BRANCHES OF BUSINESS

Trade. - Trading establishments furnished the largest number of failures, 32 assigning in October, 1941, as compared with 28 in September, 1941, and 39 in October, 1940. A decrease is noted when compared with last year. Of these 32 failures, four were general stores, 5 groceries, 4 clothing, and 2 boot and shoes.

Manufactures. - Manufacturing establishments to the number of 11 assigned in October, 1941, as compared with eight in September, 1941, and nine in October, 1940. The 11 included two in fur and leather goods, four in non-metallic minerals, and three in clothing.

Services. - In commercial services, failures numbered 13 in October, 1941, as against 16 in September, 1941, and 10 in October, 1940.


Miscellaneous, - There were six failures in construction and one in transportation.
