## COMMERCIAL FAILURES IN CANADA IN JUNE, 1926.

As compared with Juna 1925, a slight dacr ease in the number of assignments under the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts, as raported to the Dominion Bur sau of Statistics, was oxparianced in June 1926, while the liabilities of the assignors also showad a decr зぇธэ. Commercial failur es numbэred 142, as compar ad with 145 in tha same month of tha frevicus yaar, and 120 in May 1926, an incraasa baing noted in the last comparison. The lisbilitias of tho assignors amountad to $\$ 2,312,913$ as compar ad with $\$ 2,548,954$ in June 1925 and $\$ 2,065,385$ in May 1926.

## COMERCIAL FAILURES BY AREAS

Maritime Provinces.- In the month under $r$ aviaw thare ware 14 assigrments in the Maritima Frovinces, as compared with 10 in May 1926 and 9 in Juna 1925. The liabilities in Juna wore approximately $\$ 107,000$.

Quabac.- In Quebac, fāilur as in Juna 1926 numbered 46 , as compared with 39 in May 1926 and 43 in June 1925, an incr aas of 7 p.c. as compared with last yaar. The liabilitios in Juna wara in tha naighbcrhood of $\$ 899,000$.

Ontario.- Commarcial failures in Ontario number ad 49, as compared with 49 for May 1926 and 67 for June 1925-a decrease of $27 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in the latter comparison. The liabilitiэs wers about $\$ 949,000$.

Prairie provinces.- In the three prairia provinces, the failures numbered 27 in Juno, as compar wd with 14 in May 1926 and 19 in Juna 1925-an incr эase of 42 p.c. ov ar tha sama month of last yoar. The liabilitias in Juna wara approximataly \$193,000.

British Columbia.- In the Pacific provincas, commerial failur as numbered 6, as comparad with 8 in May and 8 in Jun 1925 - a dзcreas of $25 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in both compar isons. The liabilitios were abcut $\$ 16 \hbar, 000$.

## FAILIRES BY BRANCHES OF BUSINESS

Trada.- Trading эstablishments constituted as usual a majority of the failures, 70 of thess assigning in Junэ 1926, as compared with 57 for May and 74 in Jung 1925, a decline of about 3 p.c. in the lattar comparison.

Manufacturars.- Manufacturing 3 stablishments to the number of 29 assignod during June as against 26 in May and 31 in Juna 1925. Agriculturists assigning in Junə number ed 9 as compared with 7 in May and 10 in June 1925. Other failures numbarad 4 in construction, 3 in logging, and 16 in sarvica.
