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COMMERCIAL FAILURES

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE BANKRUPTCY AND WINDING UP ACTS

During the first quarter of 1960 the total number of business failures recorded under the provisions of the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts was 744, an increase of more than 34 per cent over the total of 554 insolvencies recorded for the first quarter of 1959. The estimated total of defaulted liabilities was \$73,669,000 for the first quarter of 1960, 319.5 per cent higher than the corresponding 1959 total of \$17,561,000. Average liability per failure thus rose sharply from \$32,000 in the first quarter of 1959 to \$99,000 in the same period of 1960. This large increase in the average liabilities is due largely to failures in the Mining Industry.

Failures and Liabilities by Industries

The largest number of bankruptcies occurred in the trade sector with general merchandise, automotive products, filling stations, hardware and building materials, and furniture, appliances and radios accounting for the increase of insolvencies in this sector from 224 in 1959 to 289 in the first quarter of 1960. Bankruptcies numbered 157 in the construction and 150 in the manufacturing industries. This was an increase for the construction industry of 44 per cent above the corresponding period for the previous year. Insolvencies in the manufacturing industry increased by over 37 per cent from the first quarter of 1959, the largest increase being in the clothing and iron and steel and transportation equipment industries. Bankruptcies in the services sector increased slightly in the first quarter comparison and the number of defaulting transportation businesses increased from 13 to 30. Failures in agriculture also increased from 14 to 23.

Estimated liabilities in all industries increased greatly in comparison with the first quarter of 1959, with the mining industry showing the largest increase.

Failures and Liabilities by Economic Areas

There were 440 bankruptcies in Quebec during the first quarter of 1960 in comparison with the 338 recorded in 1959. The total estimated liabilities in Quebec increased by 120 per cent, to \$17,813,000 from \$8,071,000 in the first quarter of the previous year, the average liability per failure thus increasing from \$23,879 to \$40,484 for the first quarter of 1960.

The number of insolvencies in Ontario increased greatly in the first quarter comparison to 223 from 160 and the total liabilities rose by over 660 per cent, placing the average liability per failure at \$230,200 as compared with \$41,694 for the same period of the previous year. Failures in the Prairie Provinces rose from 26 to 32, liabilities from \$185,000 to \$1,837,000 and the average liability increased from \$45,576 to \$57,400. British Columbia also recorded a greater number of business failures with 33 in the first quarter of 1960 and 18 in the same period of 1959. Liabilities increased from \$870,000 to \$2,256,000 and the average liability per failure increased from \$48,333 to \$68,360. The Atlantic Provinces failures increased from 12 to 16 but the liabilities declined from \$763,000 to \$431,000.

Failures by Size of Liability

The data presented in Table 4 indicate that 55 per cent of all failures during the first quarter involved businesses in the \$5,000 - \$25,000 liability range with all industries showing an increase in this range bracket. Failures in the \$100,000 and over group increased from 32 to 68.

Coverage

The statistics in this report are limited to bankruptcies made under federal legislation (the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts) and do not include failures, sales or seizures carried out apart from such federal legislation. Proposals from insolvent persons are not included with the bankruptcy data, but when proposals are rejected by the creditors or fail in their purpose, the proceedings may then come under the Bankruptcy Act. In Table 6 of this report the number of proposals is shown to give a general impression of the trend.
