

COMMERCAL FAILIRES IN CATADA IN JUY, 1927.
As compared with July 1926, the number of assignments under the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts, as reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, show a considerable decrease, while the liabilities of the assigners also show a decreasc. Commercial failures in Canada in July 1927 numbered 110 as compared with 140 in the same month of the previous year and 138 in June 1927. The liabilities of the assigners amounted to $\$ 2,026,449$ as compared with $\$ 2,352,078$ ir July 1926 and $\$ 2,437,981$ in June 1927.

## COMMRCLAE TAILURES BY ARYAS

Maritime Provinces.- In the month under review, there were 13 assignments in the Maritime Provinces, as compared with 6 in June of the same year, and 8 in July of the previous year. The liabilities in July were approximately $\$ 129,000$.

Quebec.- In Quebce, failures in July mere 35 as compared with 46 in June 1927 and 54 in July of the provious year, a decrease of about $35 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. being noted in the latter comparison. The liabilities were in the neighborhood of $\$ 609,000$.

Ontario.- Commercial failures in Ontario numbered 41 as compared with 60 in June 1927 and 58 in the same month of the provious year, a decrease of about $29 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. being noted in the latter comparison. The liabilitios were about $\$ 1,084,000$.

Prairie Provinces.- In the three prairie provinces, the commercial failuros numbercd 12 in July 1927, as compared with 20 in Junc 1927 and 16 in July 1926, a docrease of $25 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in the lattor comparison. The liabilities werc about $\$ 125,000$.

British Columbia. - In the Pacific Provinco, the commercial failuros numbered 9 as compared with 6 for the previous month of the samo year and 4 for the same month of the previous year. The liabilities totalled \$124,000.

## FAILURIS BY BRANCEIS OF BUSINESS

Trade.- Trading establishments constituted as usual a majority of the failures, 44 assigning in July 1927 as compared with 69 in Junc 1927 and 59 in July 1926.

Manufactures.- Manufacturing establishments to the number of 22 assigned during July 1927 as against 27 in June 1927 and 39 in July 1926, a considerable decrease boing notod as compared with last yoar.

Other failuros numberec 19 in agriculture, 4 in construction, 3 in transportation and 15 in service.

The cumulative total of cormorcial failuros for the first scven months of 1927 mas 1,000 as comparod vith $994,1,228,1,435,2,145$ ond 2,196 for tho somo poriod of 1926, 1925, 1924, 1923 and 1922 rospoctivcly. Tho defaulted liabilitios for the first seven months of 1927 vero $\$ 16,385,381$ as conpurcd with $\$ 16,546,913$, $\$ 19,315,311$, $\$ 31,777,323, \$ 37,923,491$ and $\$ 37,962,176$ for the same period of tho five proceding years. Thus defaultod liabilitios showod a doclino as comaro? wity the same poriod of the five proceding yoars.
