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## COMMERCIAL FAILURES

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Under the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts

FIRST QLARTER 1969

According to preliminary figures the total number of failures recorded under the provistons of the Bankruptcy and Winding Up Acts was 716 during the first quarter of 1969 in comparision with the revised total of 718 for the same quarter of 1968. The estimated total of the liabilities of bankrupt firms was $\$ 65,533,000$, considerably higher than the revised total of $\$ 55,714,000$ recorded in the Eirst quarter of 1968.

## Failures and Liabilities by Industries

The largest number of failures accurred in the trade sector in which there were 303 compared with 293 for the first quarter of 1968. Liabilities in this industry declined from $\$ 23,653,000$ to $\$ 13,519,000$. In the manufacturing industry the number of business failures were slightly lower but the liabilities increased from $\$ 8,394,000$ to $\$ 9,709,000$. The number of failures in the construction industry increased from 116 to 123 and the 1 iabilities from $\$ 6,281,000$ to $\$ 10,167,000$. In the Finance industry the number of insolvencies showed a decline but the liabilities showed a sharp increase from $\$ 6,731,000$ to $\$ 23,358,000$ in the 1968-69 first quarter comparison.

## Hal cas and Liabilities by Economic Areas

There were 413 business failures recorded in Quebec during the first quarter of 1969 compared with 345 for the same patesi of 1968. Estimated liabilities rose from $\$ 21,507,000$ to $\$ 32,909,000$. In Ontario the number of insolvencies declined T:man 275215 and the defaulted liabilities from $\$ 27,581,000$ to $\$ 13,902,000$ in the first quarter comparison. In the Prairie ! :ovinces the number of failures increased slightly and the liabilities increased from $\$ 2,940,000$ to $\$ 4,136,000$. In 8 ritish Z Iumbia the number of insolvencies decreased slightly but there was a sharp increase in the liabilities which rose from $\$ 2,371,000$ to $\$ 14,257,000$.

## Failures by Size of Liabilieies

The data presented in Table 4 indicates that 47.1 per cent of the bankruptcies involved businesses in the $\$ 5,000$ to $\$ 25,000$ size group, 23.3 per cent in the $\$ 25,000$ to $\$ 50,000$ range, 11.7 per cent in the $\$ 50,000$ to $\$ 100,000$ and 14.8 per cent in the $\$ 100,000$ and over brackets.

## Coverage

The statistics of fallures in this report are limited to those bankruptcies filed under Federal legislation (the Bankruptcy and Winding up Acts) and does not include failures, sales or seizures carried out under other legislation. In Table 6 the number of fallures of wage earners is shown but the amount of liabilities is not recorded. Proposals from insolvent persons are not included in the bankruptcy data but when such proposals are rejected by the creditors the proceedings may come under the Bankruptcy Act. In Table 6 the number of proposals is shown to give $s$ general impression of the trend.
