## COEGMCINL RAILUFES IN CANADA IH JULY, 1928.

As conpared with July 1928, the number of assignments under the bankruptcy and winding Up Acts, as reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, show a considerable increase, while the liabilities of the assignors show a slight ircrease. Commercial failures in Canada in July 1928 numbered 138, as compared with 130 in June 1928 and 110 in July 1927. The liabilities of the assignors, amounting to $6,054,702$, as compared with $\$ 2,194,595$ in June 1928 , showed a slight decrases, whan comored with $\$ 2,026,449$ in July 1927, a aijht incrase is inicatad.

## Comgengh matlerse Ey hatas

Muritime Frovinces. - In the month under review there were 8 assignmorts ir the Taritime Frovirces, as compared with 11 in June 1928 and 13 in July 1927, a decrease of about $39 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in the latter comparison. The liabilities ir. July were about 78,000 .
quebec.- Commercial failures in the province of quebec during July 1928 numbered 54, as igainst 46 in Jure 1928 and 39 in July 1927. Tho liabilities were approximatoly $088,000$.

Ortario.- In Ontario, the failures numbered 43 as against 48 in


Frairie Provinces. - In the three Frairie Provinces, cormercial failures totalled 22 in july 1928 , as compared with 21 in june 1988 , and 1 ir July 192\%. The liabilitise were about $\$ 181,000$.

British Columbia, - In the Pacific Frovince, comancial failures ircreased from in June lyk to 11 in July 1928 and why bo comparad with 9 in July 1927. The liabilitins wer about 299,000 .

## Falluies by Erinnches or business

Trade.- Tradine stalishments contributed as usual the largest rumber of failures, 54 assigring in July 1928, as compared with 51 in June 1928 ard 49 in July 1927. an increase of atout $10 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. as compared with the same month of last year.

Manufartures.- Manufacturing establishments to the number of 40 assigned uring July 1928, as against 32 in June 1928 ard 23 in July 1927. The 40 include 8 ergaged in the manufacture of vegetable foods, 2 ongaged in the manufacture of animal foods, 5 in fur ard leather, 3 in textiles, 3 in clcthirg, 4 in lumber and its manulactured products, 2 in iron and stael and 3 in the manufacture of nor-ferrous metals.

Agriculture. - Agriculturists assigning in July 1928 rumbered $\boldsymbol{T}$, as against 6 in Ture 1928 and 10 in July 1927.

Other Failures.- Other failures in July 1928 included 2 in minires, 3 in loggirg, ficking and trapping, 5 in construction and 3 in transportation and public utilitios.

## GUMLATVE SEVEN MOMTIS' TOTAL OR AILURES AND LIABTLITIES

Tha cumulative tutal of commorial failures for the inst seven months of 2920 as -098 , as compared with $1,000,994$ and 1,228 for the sume periods of $19<7$, 1926 and 1925 respectively. The defaulted liakilities for the first sever morthz of 1928 were $416,139,787$, as compared :íth $416,385,381, \% 16,546,913$ ard $\$ 19,315,311$ for the same periods of the three precedire years. Thus defaulted liabilities showed a decline when compared with the sane periods of 1927,1926 ard 1925.
