## COMMRTIA TAMTRES TN GHADA TH OCTOBER 1932.

A decrease in the muen of assignments under The Bankuptcy and Winding Up Acts, as reported to tho Duninion Burean o. Statistics; was experienced in October, 1932, as compared with Octoher: 193, while the liabilities of the assignors showed a very considuerable decrease. Comercial failures numbered 199 as compared with 226 in the same month of the previous ycai: and 195 in Septembur, 1932. The liabilities of the assignors arounting to $\$ 3,439,220$ as comvarec aits $\$ 12,378,396$ in October, 1931, showod a large decrease when compared with $\$ 3,926,294$ in Soptumber, 1932, a considerable decrease is noted.

## COMMFCIAL FATLURES BY ARES

Maritime provinceso. In the month under review, there were 15 assignments in the Maritime Provinces, as compared with 9 in October, 1931, and 9 in September, 1932. The liabilitios in Octoler, 1932: were about $\$ 128,000$.
guebec. - Comercial failures in the province of quebec during octobor, 1932 , numbered 80 as againct 90 in Geptemiver: 1932, and 98 in October, 1931. The liabilities were approximately $\$ I_{:} 384,000$ of ohzse 80 failures, 37 with estimated liabilit163 of about $\$ 710,000$ occurred in the city of iontreal.

Ontario. In Ontorio, the failures numbered 73 as against 64 in September, 1932, and 78 in October, 1931, Liahilities ageregated about $\$ 1,313,000$. In the city of Toronto, there were 19 assignments with liabilities of about $\$ 365,000$,

Prairie Provinces . In the three Prairie Provinces, failures increased from 21 in September: 1932; to 26 in October, 1932, and may be compared mith 28 in October, 1931. There wro 3 foiluros in the city of minnipeg with liabilities of about $\$ 18,000$.

British Columbia, in British colurbia, conmorcial failures numbered 5 as agolnst 9 in Supterbw. 1932. and 13 in Cetober, 1931. A decrease was experienced in both comparisons. The liabilitios were about $\$ 85,000$. Thero were 2 failures in Vancouver, with liabilities of about $\$ 48,000$.

## TAIIURESBY BRUTHMS OF BUSINESS

Trade.- Trading esteblishments fumished the largest number of failures, 92 assigning in ctober. 1932, as compared with 99 in Suptemoer, 1932, and 77 in October, 1931. Cf these conceins, i9 vere gencral stores, 9 grocer s6 confectionery, 2 drink and tobacco, 4 boots ind shoes, 7 fish and meat, 2 furniture, 4 hardware, 4 electric apparatus, 2 jewelry and 5 drugs and chemicals.

Manufactures.- ilanufacturing establishments to the number of 36 assigned October, 193?. as against 38 in September, 193?, and 45 in October, 1931. The 36 included 4 engaged in the ranufacture of vegetable foods, 3 in fur and leather, 5 in textiles, 2 j.n drugs and chomicals and $i$ in nonnferrous metals.

Agricultureo Agriculturists assigning in October, 1932, numbered 19, as compared with ? In Senterber. 1932, and 1.5 in October, 1931.

Services.on In Services, the failures numbered 27 as compared with 24 in Soptember, 2932 and 27 in nctiver. 1932
 finance.

The cumalative total of comacrial failures for the first ton months of 1932 was 1,995 , as compared with $1,807,1,941$ and 1,766 for the same periods of 1931,1930 and 1929, respectively. The total failures in trade in the first ten months of 1932 were 964 as compared with 897, 977 and 883 for the same periods of 1931, 1930 and 1929. In manufactures, 387 failures in the elapsed period of 1932, may be compared with 388, 395 and 367 in the same periods of the three preccding years. The defaulted liabilities for the first ten months of 1932 were $\$ 34,506,706$, as compared with $\$ 45,260,019, \$ 40,565,515$ and $\$ 32,391,423$ for the same periods of the three preceding years. Thus dofoulted liabilitios showed a decrease when compared with the some period of 1931.
