## BANK DEEIS TO INDIVIDUAL ACOOUYTS

## or

Arount of Cheques Ohwered against Sonk hocounts it the<br>Cluarins house centres in $19<9$

Financial transfers were considerably greater in Canada during 19 c 9 than in any preceding yotr, bank debits to individual accounts in the clearing house centres uxceeding by 7.4 p.c. the preceding high record ustablished in 19<8. The total value of cheques cashod auring $19<9$ in tis elearing centres was $\$ 46,670,000,000$ comparud with $\$ 43,477,000,000$ in $19<0, \$ 36,094,000,000$ in $19<7$ and $\$ 27,157,000,000$ in $19<4$, the carliest year for which these figures are available. Though trading on the stock $\theta x c h a n g e s$ showod a marked increase in 1969 , general businese operations, ospocially during the first nine months, also contributod substantially to tho axpansion in barik debits as comparud with 1960. Important fuins over ly<9 wore shown in 25 contrus out of the 31 for which complete statistics are available. The increases wore especially markod in British Columbia, where the bain in the aggregato was 17 f.c., Vancouver showing the pronounced incruse of 19 w.c. while Nuw westminster and Victoria had incruasus of 13.5 and 7 p.c., respuctively. A gain of 10.5 p.c. Was shown in the provinco of quebec, while ontario and the kiaritime provincus had uach an irceruse of about 7 p.c.. A decline in winnipe.o was the main intiluoncu in the I p.c. decline in the douits of the Prairie Frovinces.

## Comparison with $19<0$

Miaritime Frovinces. - The grestest incroases in the centres of the waritime Provinces over $19<0$, Gmounting to $\$ 3,000,000$ or $9.4 \mathrm{f} . \mathrm{c}$. , was shown in Suint Tohn, gains of 9 f.c. and 5.1 . .c. being shown in Noncton and halifax, respectively. The total in the thrue contres was $\$ 790,000,000$, a gain of 7 f.c.
quebec. - The debits of wontreal showed a gain of nearly $\$ 1,600,000,000$ or 11.5 p.c. over the high totai of 1928 , while declines were shom in quebec and Sherbrocke. The gain in the aggregate for the three centres in the province of母uebec was $10.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$.

Oniario. - Two only of the twelve centres of Ontario for which comarative statistics were available siowed decreases over 1960. The gain in Toronto was \$1,041,000,000 or 8.2 p.c. Sarnia showed a gain of 21.5 p.c., and Brantiord and Hamilton were up 15.9 p.c. and 11.6 p.c., respectively. The gain in Kitchener was $11.5 \mathrm{f.c}$. and in Chatham $10.8 \mathrm{~F} . \mathrm{c}$. The deciines in Ottawa and Fort william were 4.I p.c. and 5.6 p.c., respectivel. y . The ret result in the province as a whole was a gein of \$1, <30,000,000 or $7 \mathrm{p} \cdot \mathrm{c}$.

Prairie Provinces. - In tho Prairie Provimes, dooiines were shown in winnipeg and liodicino Hat, and in the brancnos of the weyburn oucurity bank, but tho decreases were noarly counterbalanced by gains in the remaining centres. The greatest percentage sain of 19.1 k.c. was shown in Rogina. The gain in Calgary was $\$ 156,900,000$ or 14.2 F.c., while Edmonton showed a gai n of $10.6 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. An increase of $\$ 21,000,000$ or 10 p.c. was shown in Saska toon. The debits in winnipeg, amounting to $\$ 4,709,000,000$, shawed a decrease oi $7.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. The deciine in the ageregate for the three provinces was limited to I p.c.

British Columbia. - The debits in Vancouver during 1969 reached the new high record of $\$ 4,366,000,000$, a gair. of no less i han $\$ 301,000,000$ or 19.2 p.c. over the total for 19\&8. Victoria and New westminster showed gains of $7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. and 13.5 p.c., respectively. The geir in the three centres oi British Columbia was $\$ 423,500,000$ or 17 p.c.

## Surnover of Bank Deposits

The avarage turnover of bank deposits increased in 1929 as compared with the preceding year; the averuge monthly perdentage of bank debits to the domand and notice deposits as at the end of each month was 170.0 compared with 167.5 p.c. if 1920. The average of bank deposits was practically maintained at the level of the preceding yeur, while the gain in debits was 7.4 f.c.

## Comparison with Other Factors

The index of i:dustrial production published in the Monthly Review of Business Statistics, showed an increase of $12 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in 1929 over the preceding year. The index of industrial employment, wich is normally less subject to fluctuation than indexes of the volume of production, averaged $6.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. higher in 1929. The number of shares traded on the lontreal Stock Exchange increased 22 p.c., indicating the marked activity iri speculati $n$ during 19:9. These gains in economic activity may be compared with the incrass of 7.4 p.e. in benk dabits.

## STATISTICAL TABLES

In Tuble l will be found the bank debits in each of the clearing house aentres of Canada in 1929, with the comparative figures for 1928 and the absolute and percentage increases. Table $<$ shows index numbers of bank debits in the four ainief clearing house centres with the average monthly debits during $19<t$ as a base, with adjustment for seasonal vuriation. Tables 3 and 4 show the relation of bank debits to deposits and to bank clearings for ach month of $19<8$ and $19<9$, while Table 5 gives the bank debits at each clearing house centre for each month of 1928 and 1929.
