After paragraph 2 on page 6 insert the following paragraphs:

Four provinces registered further increases in capital spending compared with the earlier 1968 estimates and the amounts spent in 1967. Newfoundland shows an increase of 14% over the 1967 total compared with an 11% increase in the original forecast, Nova Scotia 10% compared with 6%, Ontario 7% compared with 5% and Manitoba 19% compared with 16%.

Expected capital expenditures in Saskatchewan although reduced from the earlier forecast are still up 2% over the 1967 totals.



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SECTION I. RE-APPRAISAL OF 1968 CAPITAL EXPENDITURE PROGRAMME

Capital spending plans of all sectors of the Canadian economy, as revealed in a recent survey, are expected to reach \$16.0 billion in 1968. This figure exceeds the \$15.2 billion spent in 1967 by almost 6% and indicates a further increase over the \$15.8 billion of planned capital outlays reported at the beginning of 1968.

The estimates given here are comparable with those published in the April report "Private and Public Investment in Canada—Outlook 1968" and are the results of the survey conducted in May and June covering business establishments, institutions and all levels of government. Respondents were asked to revise only their estimates of capital spending during 1968 and therefore the figures shown here for repair expenditures are the same as those appearing in the earlier report.

The present estimates reflect a slight downward adjustment in expenditures for non-residential construction but additions were made to earlier estimates for housing and for new machinery and equipment. Spending on all new construction is now expected to total \$10,255 million in 1968, or about 8% above that of 1967 and a fraction of 1% above the earlier 1968 estimates. Plans for purchases of new machinery and equipment, at \$5,783 million, have also been revised upwards by 3% with the result that a marginal decline shown at the beginning of the year has been changed to an increase of 2% over 1967.

The strengthening in investment plans has occurred in both the business sector and in housing, with social capital showing some decline from the earlier estimates for 1968. Businessmen are now expected to increase their spending in 1968 by about 3%, whereas a decline of a little over 1% was estimated at the first of the year. The largest upward adjustment in business investment plans has occurred in the resource based forest and mineral group of industries. While expanded plans were reported in wood products, paper and primary metals, a major part of the gain can be attributed to the confirmation of starts on large mining developments not included in the first statements of intentions. In manufacturing, generally, outlays are still expected to be lower than in 1967 but the magnitude of the decrease is now reduced to 2% compared with 7% expected earlier in 1968. Utilities have also registered additions to earlier plans for a resultant total of 7% above 1967. Outlays by the trade, finance and commercial group show more strength at mid-year for an increase of 2% over 1967 instead of a small decline reported at the beginning of this year.

The 1968 total for housing and social capital is now showing an increase of 12% over 1967 as a result of a further gain at mid-year of 3% in housing and a 7% decrease in social capital. Government spending plans have been revised only slightly and remain at a total which is 9% above the 1967 estimate. Plans by institutions are now at a level 15% higher than 1967 but significantly lower than the earlier expectations for 1968.

Quebec and Alberta remain at about the same level of capital expenditures as indicated at the beginning of 1968. The first forecast was well above the 1967 total by 5 and 11% respectively. Spending plans in Prince Edward Island are unchanged and remain at about the same level as in 1967.

Estimates for two provinces indicate reductions in expected outlays in 1968 compared with 1967. Postponement of part of the work on some of the larger projects in manufacturing and in utilities in New Brunswick contributed to a decrease of 6% from the earlier estimates for 1968 and 18% from the 1967 level. In British Columbia, a decrease of about 1% from 1967 is now expected compared with 6% estimated at the beginning of the year.
