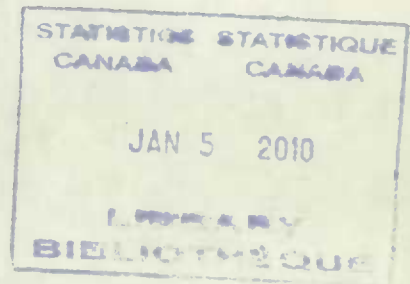

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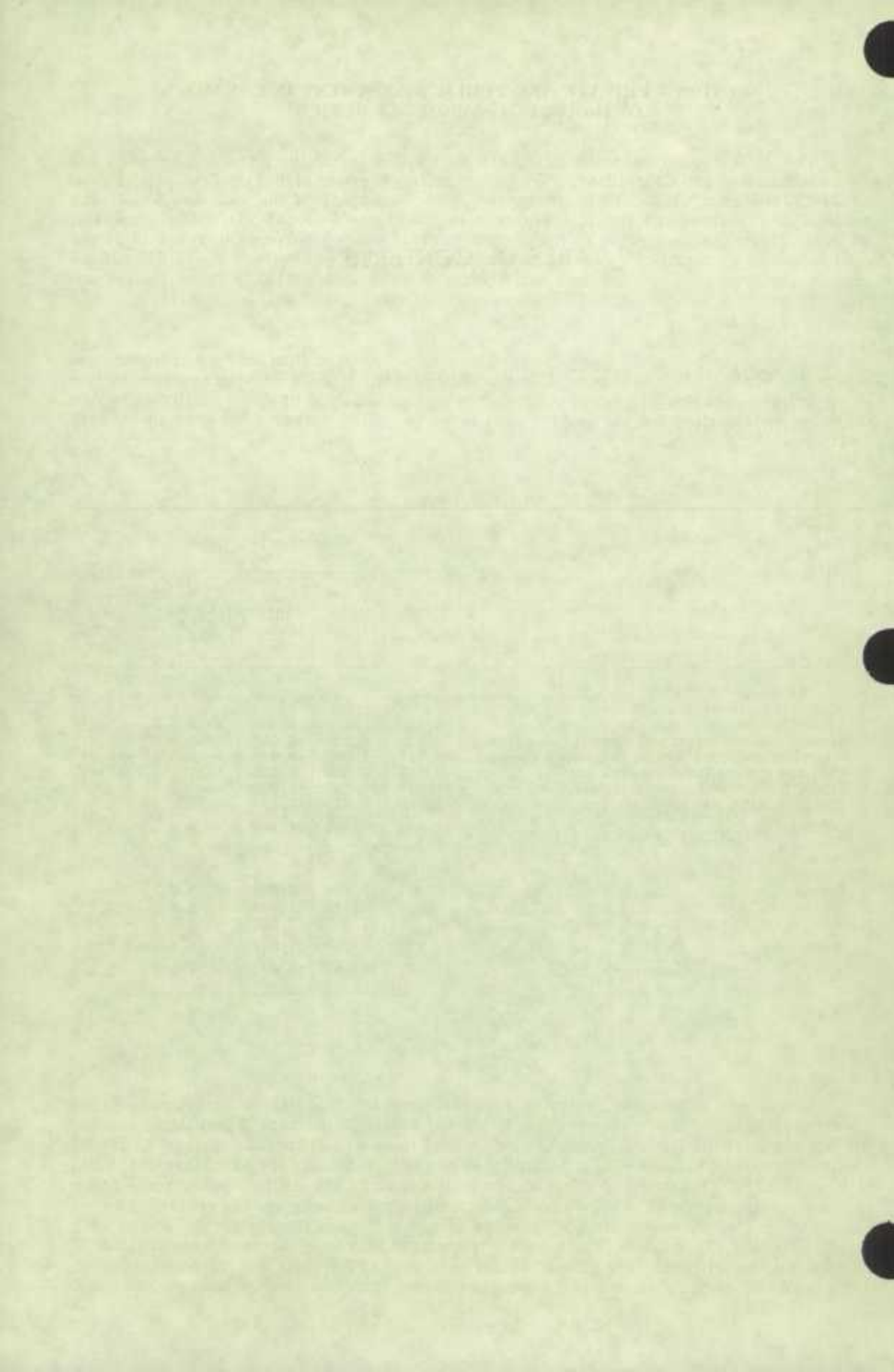
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**SECTION I PRIVATE AND PUBLIC INVESTMENT IN CANADA,
OUTLOOK 1971 - MID-YEAR REVIEW**

The 1971 capital spending intentions by all sectors of the Canadian economy are now estimated at \$19,622 million. This amount is two per cent higher than the earlier total of \$19,321 million which had been planned at the beginning of the year and which was reported in "Private and Public Investment in Canada - Outlook 1971" (Catalogue No. 61-205). The revised spending plans, if implemented, would involve an increase of 11 per cent in capital expenditures over the preliminary actual level of outlays of \$17,640 million on new construction and machinery and equipment estimated for 1970. These figures are in terms of dollar value, and if allowances are made for price changes the increase would be somewhat less.

These estimates of intended capital spending are derived from surveys of investment intentions conducted by Statistics Canada which cover business establishments, institutions and governments. The most recent survey in May and June updated earlier estimates of expected spending for the current year reported in the survey completed in January 1971.

The latest information indicates a further increase of slightly more than one per cent in total plans for new construction to a level nearly 15 per cent higher than comparable outlays in 1970. The 1971 total is now planned to be \$12,849 million compared with the earlier estimate of \$12,678 million for this year and the preliminary actual outlays of \$11,211 million in 1970. The expected value of new housing, at \$3,806 million, is unchanged from the earlier estimate for 1971 whereas anticipated expenditures on non-residential construction rose to \$9,043 million, or two per cent higher than the previously stated 1971 intention of \$8,872 million. The revised programme for non-residential construction, if carried out, would result in a gain of 11 per cent over 1970, while the currently expected 1971 level for housing is nearly 24 per cent higher than comparable outlays last year.

The planned acquisition of new machinery and equipment is also expected to increase further by two per cent to \$6,773 million over the earlier estimate of \$6,643 million for 1971, for a gain of more than five per cent over the preliminary actual 1970 total of \$6,429 million if fully implemented.

Revisions in spending plans for 1971 since the beginning of the year were concentrated predominantly in the business sector. The new level of expected outlays, at \$11,806 million, is an additional two per cent higher than the earlier estimate for 1971, and nearly nine per cent above the preliminary 1970 total. In this sector, notable increases were reported in mining, manufacturing, finance and commercial services. Re-assessments of spending plans in metal mining and oil and gas wells in particular contributed to an increase in the total for mining of six per cent over the earlier 1971 estimate and to a level 35 per cent higher than preliminary actual outlays for 1970. A gain of two per cent in manufacturing capital spending plans over the earlier estimate for 1971 softened the expected decline in planned capital outlays in this sector to some four per cent from the preliminary total for 1970. A reduction of nearly six per cent was expected in manufacturing at the beginning of 1971. Up-dating of anticipated expenditures reported in January on new construction, machinery and equipment amongst paper manufacturing and processing firms, wood products, and in printing and publishing were in the main responsible for changes for manufacturing as a whole. Plans in the chemical products group and oil refineries were revised downwards at mid-year by \$17.1 million and \$9.6 million. Other manufacturing industries registered only minor changes.

Planned capital outlays in agriculture and wholesale and retail trade showed little change from the level of spending expected early in 1971. Downward revisions occurred in the forestry group and utilities, particularly in the former category. In contrast, planned capital outlays as currently reported for the finance and commercial services groups showed an extra \$73 million due mainly to real estate development and to intended spending for hotels.

Capital outlays for social purposes are little changed from plans formulated at the beginning of the year. The programme for housing is expected to continue at the level of \$3,806 million anticipated at the start of 1971, and the total for governments also follows the earlier estimated level. Institutional services indicate some additions to new capital outlays for provincial schools, which was the main factor in the gain of \$46 million in the spending programmes for this group between mid-year and the beginning of 1971.

Provincially, the revised estimates show increases at mid-1971 for most provinces except Prince Edward Island which remains virtually unchanged, and for New Brunswick and Manitoba where planned capital expenditures now indicate small reductions from earlier intentions. The mid-year estimates reflect the firming of plans and the up-dating of information on a number of large projects.

In the Atlantic Region, only minor changes were made to the earlier estimates for the primary industries and for the trade-finance-commercial group of industries. There was a reduction in the total planned for manufacturing in New Brunswick caused by some stretching out of spending programmes, but increases were noted for Nova Scotia and Newfoundland, mainly in petroleum and coal in Nova Scotia and food and beverages in Newfoundland. Changes for utilities and for institutions and governments were moderate regionally with the largest being an increase in expected electric power outlays in Nova Scotia and by institutions and governments for Newfoundland.

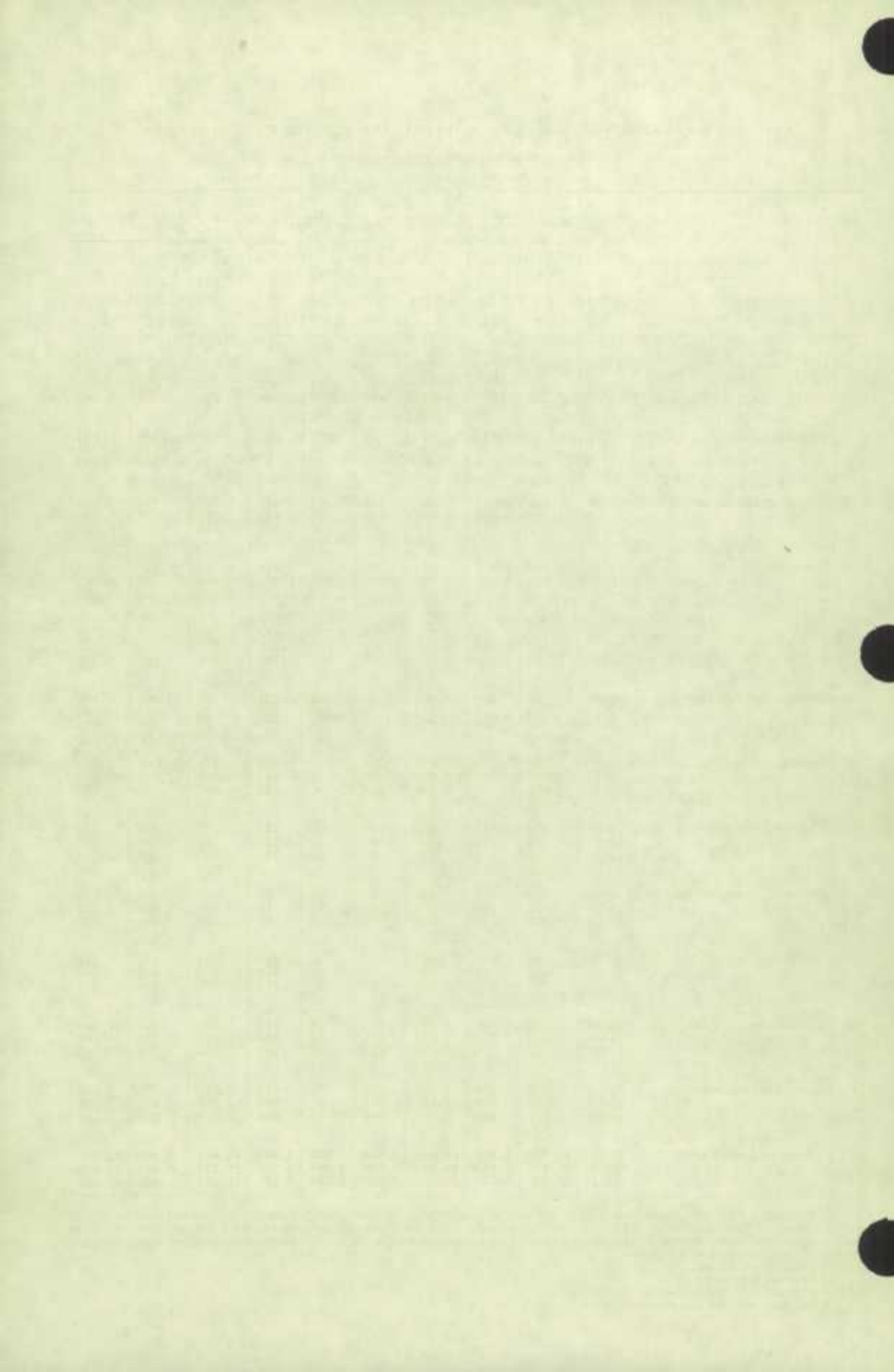
The Central Provinces of Quebec and Ontario were virtually unchanged at mid-year following the re-assessment of spending plans. The new total for Quebec, at \$3,966 million, is only slightly higher than the \$3,833 million expected earlier in the year. Manufacturing shows a decrease of \$17 million following reductions in plans for paper products, chemicals, oil refineries, electrical products and transportation equipment. Off-setting increases were registered mainly for primary metals processing. Some additional strength was also shown in the primary industries and institutions and governments. Utilities and the trade-finance-commercial industries were not revised significantly and

housing intentions are unchanged. In Ontario, a marginal increase resulted in a total of \$7,470 million compared with \$7,462 million estimated in the first compilation of 1971 intentions. Manufacturing is down following decreases mainly in spending intentions by primary metals processing, paper products and oil refineries. Institutional and government capital spending plans also indicated some contraction. On the other hand, expected outlays by primary industries and the trade-finance-commercial group of industries were expanded further during this year. Utilities and housing programmes are almost unchanged.

The Western Provinces have shown added strength as a group at mid-year with a few exceptions. In Manitoba, a major revision to estimates for mining in the earlier 1971 figures lowered the total for primary industries. The manufacturing total was revised downward by about nine per cent and the housing estimates by nearly six per cent at mid-year. Decreases in these sectors and in the trade-finance-commercial services group were not fully counter-balanced by the limited increases at mid-year in planned outlays by utilities, and institutions and governments. Revisions for Saskatchewan were most heavily concentrated in a gain for the primary industries group and for the manufacturing total. The institutions and governments figure was lowered, and estimated outlays on housing declined by 19 per cent to \$55 million. Alberta's higher level of expected spending originated in housing, the primary industries group, manufacturing, the trade-finance-commercial services group, and institutions and governments, with some offsetting decline for utilities. Housing is now expected to increase by \$84 million or 26 per cent.

In British Columbia, all major groupings of industries show increases in planned spending except utilities and housing. Primary industries and most of manufacturing were the major contributors to the addition to the total. A slight slackening in outlays by utilities was minor in comparison with the gains. The outlook for housing, however, was moderated by 5 per cent or \$30 million.

The estimates for capital expenditures in this publication represent the current dollar spending plans as reported by respondents at the time the survey was made. The rate of increase from the outlays for 1971 anticipated at the beginning of the year is very similar to that observed in the recent past. However, the actual accomplishment of the programme depends upon a variety of conditions external and internal to the organizations formulating these capital spending intentions.

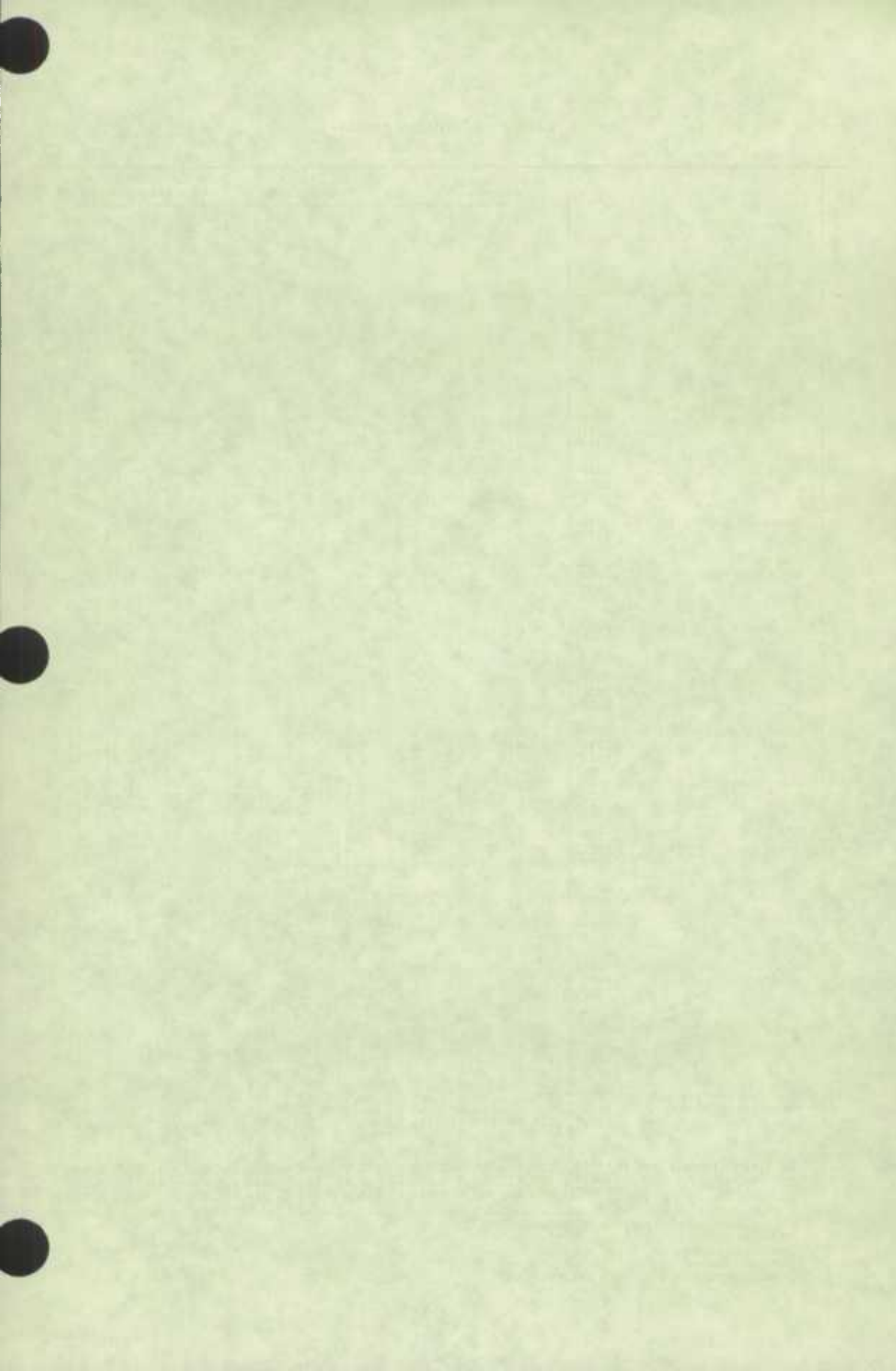

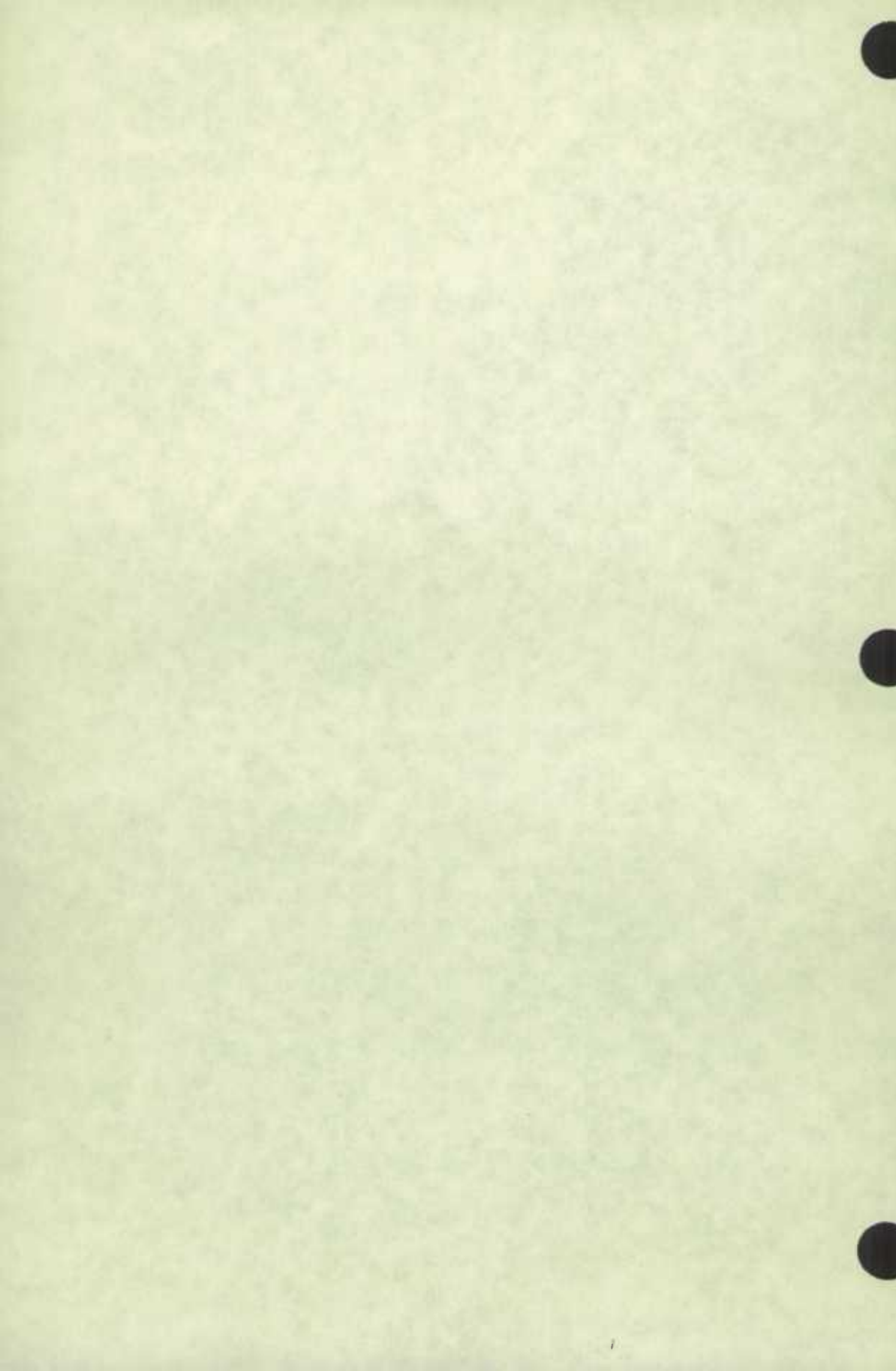
