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SECTION I PRIVATE AND PUBLIC INVESTMENT IN CANADA, OUTLOOK 1972 - MID-YEAR REVIEW

The 1972 capital spending intentions by all sectors of the Canadian economy are now estimated at \$21,151 million. This amount is two per cent higher than the earlier total of \$20,760 million which had been planned at the beginning of the year and which was reported in "Private and Public Investment in Canada - Outlook 1972" (Catalogue 61-205). The revised spending plans, if implemented, would involve an increase of seven percent in capital expenditures over the preliminary actual level of outlays of \$19,788 million on new construction and machinery and equipment estimated for 1971. These figures are in terms of current dollar value, and if allowances are made for price changes the increase would be somewhat less.

These estimates of intended capital spending are derived from surveys of investment intentions conducted by Statistics Canada which cover business establishments, institutions and governments. The most recent survey in May and June up-dated earlier estimates of expected spending for the current year reported in the survey completed in January 1972.

The latest information indicates a further increase of one percent in total plans for new construction to a level five percent higher than comparable outlays in 1971. The 1972 total is now planned to be \$13,767 million compared with the earlier estimate of \$13,685 million for this year and the preliminary actual outlays of \$13,114 million in 1971. The expected value of new housing, at \$4,274 million, is marginally higher than the earlier estimate for 1972 whereas anticipated expenditures on non-residential construction rose to \$9,493 million, or one percent higher than the previously stated 1972 intentions of \$9,431 million. The revised programme for non-residential construction, if carried out, would result in a gain of three percent over 1971, while the currently expected 1972 level for housing is nine percent higher than comparable outlays last year.

The planned acquisition of new machinery and equipment is also expected to increase further by four percent to \$7,384 million over the earlier estimate of \$7,075 million for 1972, for a gain of eleven percent over the preliminary actual 1971 total of \$6,674 million if fully implemented.

Revisions in spending plans for 1972 since the beginning of the year were concentrated predominantly in the business sector. The new level of expected outlays, at \$12,557 million, is an additional three percent higher than the earlier estimates for 1972, and seven percent above the preliminary 1971 total. In this sector, notable increases were reported in manufacturing, utilities and the trade-finance-commercial group industries. A gain of five percent in manufacturing spending plans over the earlier estimate for 1972 changed the expected decline in planned capital outlays in this sector to a gain of two percent over the preliminary total for 1971. A reduction of two percent was looked for in manufacturing at the beginning of 1972. Up-dating of expected expenditures reported in January on new construction and machinery and equipment was significant among producers of foods and beverages, and of chemicals, rubber and non-metallic mineral products. Estimates for oil refineries were revised downwards at mid-year by \$22 million. Other manufacturing industries registered smaller changes.

Planned capital outlays in agriculture, forestry and mining showed little change from the level of spending expected early in 1972. A downward revision occurred in the mining group mainly as a result of delays in achieving the programme expected earlier on some projects. In contrast, planned capital outlays as currently reported for the trade, finance and commercial services groups showed an extra \$81 million. Utilities were also up by \$163 million largely as a result of increases for electric power and pipelines.

Capital outlays for social purposes are unchanged from plans formulated at the beginning of the year. The programme for housing is expected to be marginally higher, at \$4,274 million, than the \$4,254 million anticipated at the start of 1972. Institutional services indicate some additions to new capital outlays for schools which was the main contributing factor in the gain of two percent in the spending programme for this group between mid-year and the beginning of 1972. The total for governments is two percent lower than the earlier estimated level and eight percent above the 1971 level.

Provincially, the results of the mid-year survey show upward revisions for most provinces except Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick and British Columbia, including the Territories. The mid-year estimates reflect the firming of plans and the up-dating of information on a number of large projects.

In the Atlantic region, an upward adjustment of twenty percent was made to the earlier estimates for manufacturing, attributable in large part to additions to the programmes in Nova Scotia. The trade-finance-commercial group is indicating significant added strength in all the provinces of the region but utilities are almost unchanged regionally. Housing and social capital are decreasing in each of the four provinces except New Brunswick where the institutions and governments group increased moderately from the earlier expectations for 1972.

In Quebec estimated spending was higher at mid-year following a re-assessment of spending plans. The new total for Quebec, at \$4,655 million, is four percent above the \$4,456 million expected earlier in the year. Manufacturing shows an increase of \$51 million following expansions of plans for food and beverages, paper products and a number of other industries. Significant added strength was registered for utilities with smaller gains shown for primary industries, trade-finance-commercial and for institutions and governments. An offsetting decrease was registered for housing.

In Ontario, a marginal increase brings estimated outlays for 1972 to \$7,764 million compared with \$7,756 million estimated in the first compilation of 1972 intentions. Manufacturing remains unchanged as decreases mainly for primary metals offset a number of small increases throughout the group. Primary industries, utilities, institutional services and governments indicated some contraction but outlays for commercial building and for housing were expanded further during this year.

The Prairie Provinces have shown added strength as a group at mid-year with a few exceptions. Manufacturing and the trade-finance-commercial group have increased planned outlays mainly in Alberta while the expansion in utilities and housing is general for the region except for housing activities in Saskatchewan which decreased from earlier estimates from 1972. The total for institutions and governments was lowered regionally.

In British Columbia and the Territories, manufacturing, utilities, institutions and governments show increases in planned outlays but the primary industries, trade-finance-commercial and housing are lower compared with earlier estimates for 1972. One of the factors in the decreases was a readjustment of some projects in mining.

The estimates for capital expenditures in this publication represent the current dollar spending plans as reported by respondents at the time the survey was made. Actual accomplishment of the programme depends upon a variety of conditions external and internal to the organizations formulating these capital spending intentions.
