## FABM TMPLGREAT AND EGUA PMENT SALES

First Quarter: 1959

This first quarterly report on farm implement and equipment sales in Canada shows estimates of total sales and the number of selected majer implements sold based upos data reported by a panel of large f1rms. It covers the first thres thonths of the calendar year and includes comperisons whth the same period of 1958.

The percentage of the total business done in each category by the reporting firms is known from the last annual survey of all firms in the industry. This percentage is applied to the totals of these firms for the current period to obtain the over-all estimate. When final 19!8 annual totais are known the 1957 "blow-up" factors now used may be changed and, if significant, revisions to this series will be in order. The implements specified in this report were seiected because of their importance and because the perisentage accounted for by the main-line companies was high.

In this report, preliminary estimates for the entire year 1958 are also shown, based upon the sales of the same pane.. of firms and calculated in the same manner as described above. The sales of repair parts are included in the total; in the regular annual reports up to and inciuding 1957, totals of new machines and zquipment and of repair parts were shown separately. The number of units sold are dealers saies to the user; the dollar estimates represent total sales to the user bat at the wholesale price level.
