## FARM IMPLEMENT AND EQUIPMENT SALES

Fourth Quarter, 1960

Preliminary estimates of farm implement and equipment sales for 1960 reveal a nominal gain of 3 per cent over 1959 to a total of \$258,728,845. This figure includes \$38,259,504 sales of repair parts which decreased slightly from the 1959 total of \$38,887,438. No unusual movement of sales occurred in the lines shown in this report: Wheel type tractor sales fell slightly from 25,437 units in 1959 to 24,624 units sold in 1960; both pull type and self propelled combine sales were lower as were hay balers and swathers. The shift to diesel wheel type tractors continued in 1960. During 1959 these tractors accounted for approximately 54 per cent of the total number sold in Canada; in 1960 the ratio rose to 62 per cent.

This report covers 12 months business and differs from the first three quarterly reports in that more detail can be made available. The estimates are based upon the reporting of a panel of main-line companies whose ratios to the 1959 totals are known. They are subject to revision when the total coverage annual report for 1960 is completed later this year. Units sold represent sales to user while the dollar estimates are at the wholesale level.
