

NOTES

... Sales reported in this series include only original sales of machinery in Canada. Manufacturers report only sales of goods of their own manufacture or of goods which they imported. Distributors report only sales of goods imported directly by them. Figures include sales made to Canadian customers only; export sales have been excluded.

... Value figures generally represent wholesale values.

... Used machinery, binder twine, and motor trucks are not included.

... Sales of attachments have been included with the machines for which they were sold.

FARM IMPLEMENT AND EQUIPMENT SALES

1950

Sales of New Farm Machinery and Equipment

Farm machinery sales in Canada during 1950 barely surpassed the 1949 volume. The dollar value of implements and equipment sold totalled \$218,187,120 compared with 1949 sales of \$217,089,685. These figures and the values appearing throughout the tables of this report, are mainly at wholesale prices. On the basis of information supplied by manufacturers and importer-distributors, an average mark-up of 20.4% would produce a reasonably accurate estimate of expenditures by Canadian farmers on new implements and equipment in 1950. Retail sales of farm machinery, estimated on this basis, amounted to approximately \$263,000,000 in 1950.

There was wide variation in the 1949-1950 trends for different sections of the country. Manitoba, which had shown a 60% increase in 1949, reported sales 22% lower in 1950. Alberta and Saskatchewan reported only small gains of 2% and 5% respectively. British Columbia reported a 28% decline from the 1949 sales figure. In eastern parts of the country, increases ranged from 9% to 15%.

The following table shows the regional distribution of farm machinery and equipment sales for 1944 to 1950. It may be noted that the total for the three Prairie Provinces was 62.8% of the Canada total in 1950, somewhat lower than the 65.2% recorded in the previous year.

Among the commodity items, as can be seen from Table 2, there were distinctly different trends for various groups. Tractors and engines, the largest group by volume, showed a decrease of 4% from 1949. Another important group showing reduced volume was "Ploughs" which declined 15%. Although farm wagons, trucks and sleighs showed a decrease

of 21% and poultry equipment a decline of 21%, these are less important parts of the farm implement class.

Increases in certain other goods kept total volume at the previous year's level, among the more important of these being tilling, cultivating and weeding machinery (+ 8%) and harvesting machinery (+ 13%).

In this report, detailed commodity information is given for the period from 1944 to 1950 bringing together in more permanent

form a historical series somewhat similar to the 1940-43 summary presented in the report for the year 1943. (See Table 6).

Sales of Repair Parts

Sales of repair parts for farm machinery and equipment totalled \$29,862,034 in 1950, up 6% from \$28,104,505 reported in 1949. On the basis of supplementary information provided by reporting firms which indicated an average markup of 31.4%, it is estimated that farmers in Canada spent approximately \$39,000,000 on repair parts for farm machinery in 1950.

The trend in repair parts sales varied considerably in the different regions of the country. In British Columbia, the Atlantic Provinces and Quebec, major increases of 69%, 55% and 49% respectively were recorded. Repair parts sales in Manitoba and Saskatchewan were down 8% and 10% respectively up from 1949, while moderate gains of 7% and 17% were recorded for Alberta and Ontario. The following table shows provincial sales for the years 1949 and 1950.



Sales of Farm Implements and Equipment Compared with Farm Cash Income, 1936-1950

Farm cash income showed a decrease of 11% from the 1949 volume. The sale of farm products diverged from that of farm implements which maintained the record of high

volume reached in 1949. The following chart presents a comparison of farm cash income and sales of farm implements and equipment.
