NOTES

... Sales reported in this series include only original sales of machinery in Canada. Manufacturers report only sales of goods of their own manufacture or of goods which they imported. Distributors report only sales of goods imported directly by them. Figures include sales made to Canadian customers only; export sales have been excluded.

... Value figures generally represent wholesale values.

... Used machinery, binder twine, and motor trucks are not included.

... Sales of attachments have been included with the machines for which they were sold.

FARM IMPLEMENT AND EQUIPMENT SALES

1951

Sales of farm implements and equipment totalled \$235,620,345 in 1951, representing an increase of 8% over the 1950 sales of \$218,187,120. Value figures appearing throughout the tables of this report, are chiefly at wholesale prices. Manufacturers and importer-distributors were asked to submit a percentage mark-up to be applied to their wholesale sales in order that estimated retail values could be arrived at. On the basis of information supplied, an average mark-up of 21.7% would produce a fairly accurate estimate of expenditures by Canadian farmers on new implements and equipment during 1951. Retail sales, estimated on this basis amounted to approximately \$287,000,000 in 1951.

The 1950-1951 trends varied widely in different sections of the country. British Columbia, which had registered a 28%

decrease in sales in 1950, reported sales 23% higher in 1951. Manitoba followed the same trend with increased sales of 8% in 1951 compared to a 22% decline in 1950. Alberta showed a 7% gain in sales, while Saskatchewan with a decline of 2% was the only province to register a drop in sales during 1951. In the eastern parts of the country, increases ranged from 13% to 26%.

The following table shows the regional distribution of farm implement and equipment sales for 1945 to 1951. It may be noted that total sales for the Prairie Provinces was 59.9% of the Canada total in 1951, this is somewhat lower than the 62.8% reported in the previous year.

Table 2 shows the volume of sales by major groups of commodities. Sales of tractors and engines, the largest group by volume, declined 5% from 1950 as did tilling, cultivating, and weeding machinery but these decreases in volume of sales were more than compensated for by the substantial increases in

sales of such important groups as harvesting machinery, haying machinery, and machines for preparing crops for market use. Increases were reported in all other groups with the exceptions of dairy machinery and equipment, and miscellaneous farm equipment where declines in sales of 16% and 0.5% were reported.

Sales of Repair Parts

Sales of repair parts for farm implements and equipment totalled \$28,772,869 in 1951, down 4% from the 1950 sales of \$29,862,034. Supplementary information provided by reporting firms indicated an average mark up of 33% and on this basis, it is estimated that farmers in Canada spent approximately \$38,000,000 on repair parts for farm implements and equipment during 1951.

The trend in sales of repair parts varied considerably in the different regions of Canada. Newfoundland recorded an in-

crease of 19% in sales of repair parts while Ontario and Saskatchewan registered gains of 2% over 1951. Manitoba sales remained the same as in 1950. British Columbia sales of repair parts decreased 45% from last year while the Maritimes, Quebec, and Alberta reported decreases of 28%, 12%, and 5% respectively. The following table shows provincial sales for the years 1945 to 1951.

Sales of Farm Implements and Equipment compared with Farm Cash Income, 1936-1951.

than in the previous year. The following chart presents a comparison of farm cash income and sales of farm implements and equipment.


