#### NOTES

Sales reported in this series include only original sales of machinery in Canada. Manufacturers report only sales of goods of their own manufacture or of goods which they imported. Distributors report only sales of goods imported directly by them. Figures include sales made to Canadian customers only; export sales have been excluded.

Value figures represent wholesale values.

Used machinery, binder twine, and motor trucks are not included.

Sales of attachments have been included with the machines for which they were sold.



# FARM IMPLEMENT AND EQUIPMENT SALES

1953

Sales of new farm implements and equipment in 1953 decreased from the previous year by approximately 5 p.c. The volume of sales at wholesale prices amounted to \$238,050,354, only slightly higher than the 1951 dollar level. Information submitted by reporting firms indicates an average mark-up of 22.8 p.c. to produce approximate retail sales of \$292,326,000. Substantial gains were evidenced in Newfoundland and Saskatchewan (+10.8 p.c. and +5.9 p.c. respectively), while sales in all other provinces were lower than in 1952. Sales of farm imple-

ments and equipment in the Prairie Provinces, at \$159,666,338 in 1953, were only fractionally lower than the 1952 sales of \$160,942,935. These three provinces accounted for 67.1 p.c. of total sales in Canada in 1953 compared with 64.3 p.c. in 1952 and 59.9 p.c. in 1951. Sales in Saskatchewan, the largest single province, were responsible for this continued expansion in the prairie proportion to total sales. The following table shows distribution of sales by regions since 1947.

Sales of tractors and engines, the largest major commodity group, have declined consistently from a 1949 total of \$102,026,000 to \$85,261,224 in 1953. The 1953 decline from the previous year occurred in that part of the country outside of the Prairies where a nominal increase of 0.6 p.c. took place. Harvesting machinery declined 6.4 p.c. in value in 1953 but

was still higher, at \$69,579,783, than other years prior to 1952. Sales of haying machinery increased 14.8 p.c. with a most pronounced gain in the Prairie Provinces of 51.8 p.c. Sales of ploughs decreased while tilling and cultivating equipment sales showed a 5.5 p.c. gain. Other commodity group sales are shown below.

**Sales of Repair Parts**

A slight increase in the sale of repair parts brought the 1953 sales, at wholesale prices, up to \$31,818,818 compared with \$31,231,946 in 1952. An average reported mark-up of 33.5 p.c. places farmers' expenditures for these parts at \$42,478,000.

Most regions reported nominal gains in repair part sales with Quebec showing a 7.6 p.c. gain, Newfoundland and

British Columbia showed the largest percentage declines (-24.5 p.c. and -15.1 p.c.) but the dollar volume was much lighter than in the other regions. These declines follow substantial increases in sales of repair parts the previous year in these two provinces.


Certain changes in commodity breakdown, particularly in tractors, preclude direct comparison with previous years as

shown in Table 5. More detail on size of tractor, combine or disk, will, it is hoped, make the figures of greater value to users of these statistics.

**Sales of Farm Implements and Equipment Compared with Farm Cash Income, 1937-1953**

Farm cash income decreased 3.0 p.c. from the 1952 volume while sales of farm implements and equipment were 5 p.c.

lower than in the previous year. The following chart presents a comparison of farm cash income and sales of farm implements and equipment.
