NOTES

Sales reported in this series include only original sales of machinery in Canada. Manufacturers report only sales of goods of their own manufacture or of goods which they imported. Distributors report only sales of goods imported directly by them. Figures include sales made to Canadian customers only; export sales have been excluded.

Value figures represent wholesale values.

Used machinery, binder twine, and motor trucks are not included.

Sales of attachments have been included with the machines for which they were sold.

FACTS ABOUT FARM AND EQUIPMENT SALES

1980

During 1980, farm and equipment sales were down 10% from 1979. This was due to a combination of factors, including a decline in the number of farms and a shift in the types of equipment being sold.

The total value of farm and equipment sales in 1980 was \$1.2 billion, compared with \$1.3 billion in 1979. This represents a decrease of 8% in total sales value.

The decline in sales was most pronounced in the category of tractors, which saw a 15% drop in sales volume. This was due to a combination of factors, including a decline in the number of tractors being sold and a shift in the types of tractors being sold.

The decline in sales was also reflected in the number of farms, which fell by 10% from 1979 to 1980. This was due to a combination of factors, including a decline in the number of farms being sold and a shift in the types of farms being sold.

FARM IMPLEMENT AND EQUIPMENT SALES

1955

Canadian sales of farm implements and equipment during 1955 amounted to \$155,115,882. Compared to 1954 this amount showed an increase of \$8,413,187 or 5.7 per cent. It should be noted that 1953 and 1954 sales both registered a decrease over the previous year. Saskatchewan with a decrease of 11.4 per cent was the only province showing a drop in sales. British Columbia registered the highest increase in sales with 23.0 per cent and Manitoba the smallest with 0.7 per cent.

The distribution of sales by major groups showed that nine groups registered gains over the preceding year while the other five groups registered declines. The largest gain (22.7 per cent) occurred in haying machinery and the largest decrease (19.4 per cent) in ploughs. The ratio of sales for the Prairie Provinces to total Canadian sales was 50.0 per cent the lowest since this

series began in 1936. Ratios of the Prairies to Canada total for commodity groups are shown in Table 3. Separate sales data for the Prairies for these commodities were first collected in 1945.

Sales of repair parts in 1955 increased 4.1 per cent to \$28,451,964 from \$27,335,796 recorded for the previous year. Newfoundland and Saskatchewan were the only provinces which did not share in this increase. The other provinces had increases ranging from 3.7 per cent in Ontario to 20.3 per cent in British Columbia.

Dollar values are stated at wholesale prices and information submitted by reporting firms indicates an average retail mark-up of 22.3 per cent and 33.3 per cent would produce approximate retail sales respectively for sales of farm implements and equipment and sales of repair parts.

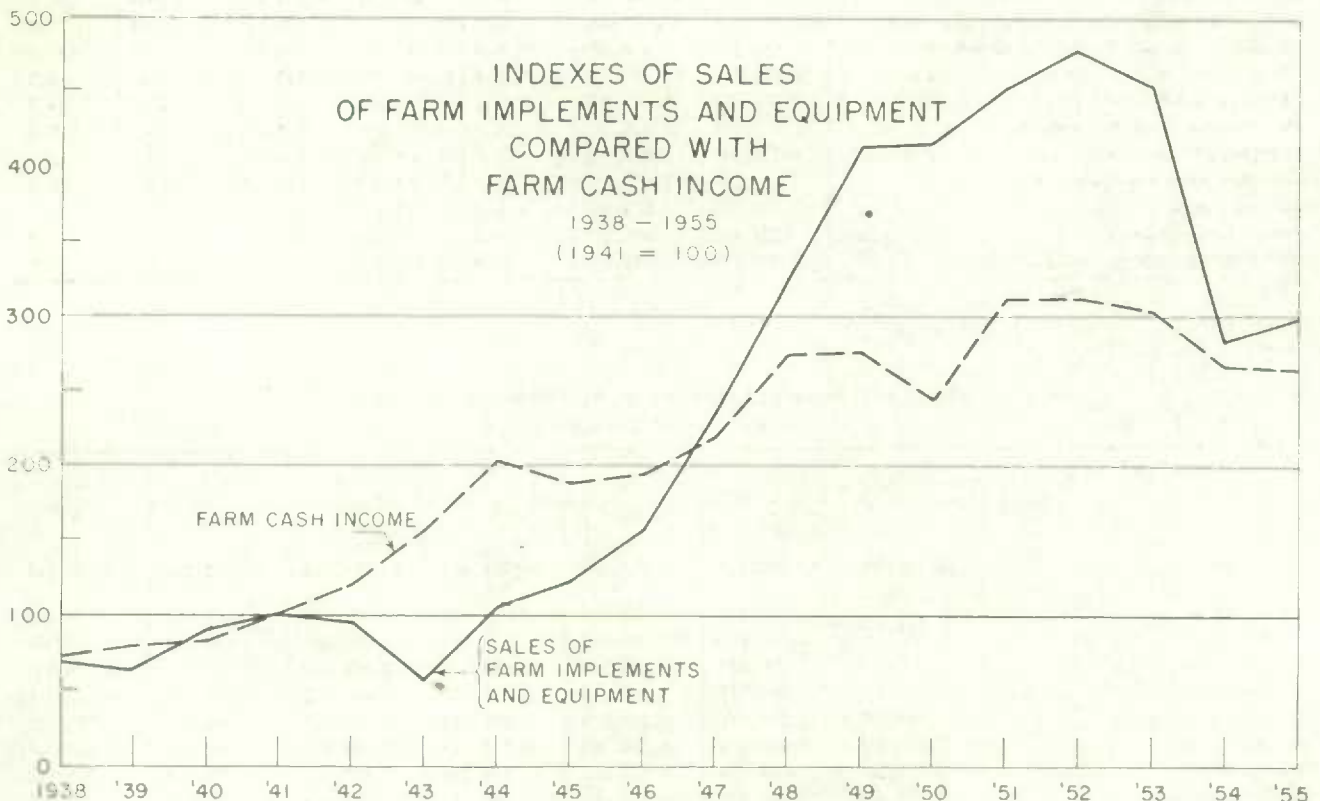
