



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La Section III présente les dépenses particulières et les frais généraux en pourcentage des recettes totales. Les dépenses particulières sont aussi données en pourcentage des recettes provenant des divers services. Ces chiffres se rapportent à un certain nombre d'hôtels constitués en société qui ont déclaré 76 chambres ou plus.

DEFINITIONS

An establishment is classed as an hotel and included in this survey only if it fits into one of the following categories:

Full-year Hotels, Licensed

Establishments with six or more hotel type rooms accessible from the interior providing lodging or lodgings and meals for transient guests and licensed to sell beer, wine or liquor. Services such as room service, dining room, banquet and convention facilities, lobby, adjoining parking lot and/or underground garage are usually provided. Establishments designated as motor hotels as distinguished from motels usually come into this classification. To be considered a full year hotel, an establishment must be operated for at least ten months in the year.

Full-year Hotels, Non-licensed

Establishments having the qualifications mentioned above, but which do not sell alcoholic beverages.

Seasonal Hotels, Licensed

Establishments with six or more rooms providing lodging or lodgings and meals for transient guests, licensed to sell beer, wine or liquor and open less than ten months of the year. Generally, the establishment must have six or more hotel type rooms in the main lodge. An exception is made in the case of resort hotels where sleeping accommodation is provided in the form of cabins or cottages but a central dining room, administration and entertainment facilities are provided in the main lodge.

Seasonal hotels include such businesses as resort hotels, hunting or fishing lodges, ski lodges or chalets, and dude ranches.

Seasonal Hotels, Non-licensed

Establishments having the qualifications listed for seasonal hotels above but which do not sell alcoholic beverages.

DÉFINITIONS

Seuls les établissements qui correspondent à l'une des catégories suivantes ont été classés comme hôtel et compris dans l'enquête:

Hôtels autorisés ouverts toute l'année

Établissement ayant au moins six chambres du type chambre d'hôtel, accessible de l'intérieur de l'établissement, fournissant le logement, ou le logement et le couvert aux voyageurs, et ayant une licence pour la vente de bière, de vin ou de spiritueux. Fournit en règle générale des services du genre du service dans les chambres, salle à manger, salles pour banquets et réunions, hall d'entrée, parc à voitures adjacent ou garage souterrain, ou les deux à la fois. Les établissements connus sous la désignation d'hôtels pour automobilistes, par opposition aux motels, entrent dans la présente catégorie. Pour être classé comme hôtel ouvert toute l'année, l'établissement doit être ouvert pendant au moins dix mois de l'année.

Hôtels non autorisés ouverts toute l'année

Hôtels comportant les caractéristiques ci-dessus, mais ne vendant aucune boisson alcoolique.

Hôtels autorisés saisonniers

Établissement de six chambres ou plus fournit le logement, ou le logement et le couvert aux voyageurs, et ayant une licence pour la vente de bière, de vin ou de spiritueux, et qui reste ouvert moins de dix mois par année. Généralement, l'établissement doit comporter au moins six chambres dans l'édifice principal. On déroge à cette règle dans le cas des hôtels saisonniers de villégiature où des cabines ou chalets tiennent lieu de chambres, mais où la salle à manger, le bureau et les salles aménagées pour les divertissements sont réunis dans le bâtiment principal.

Les hôtels saisonniers comprennent les hôtels de villégiature, les chalets de chasse ou de pêche, les pavillons ou chalets de ski, et les ranchs pour touristes

Hôtels non autorisés saisonniers

Établissement comportant les caractéristiques énumérées ci-dessus pour les hôtels saisonniers, mais ne vendant aucune boisson alcoolique.

INTRODUCTION

This report covers the calendar year 1966 and summarizes results from the eighteenth consecutive annual survey of hotels in Canada. Section I of the report presents the basic data collected from all hotels under the heading "Principal Statistics". Section II shows selected expense items supplied by medium-size hotels (11 to 75 rooms inclusive) expressed as percentages of total receipts. Section III gives a detailed breakdown of expenses of large hotels (76 rooms or more), classified into general and departmental expenses and expressed in ratio form.

When interpreting figures contained in this report, the reader should note the following points: (1) the report includes only those establishments that satisfy the definitions of hotels appearing on the preceding page and do not include tourist camps, motels, cabins and other types of accommodation; (2) the expense ratios in Section II and III are not directly comparable to those for years prior to 1956. In the case of Section II, beginning in 1956 all large hotels (100 rooms or more - 76 or more from 1965) and all hotels having 10 rooms or less were excluded from this section of the survey.

It should also be noted that data relating to coverage, revenue and expenditures contained in this report are not strictly comparable to the data released in the 1966 Census of Merchandising and Services. Variations occur mainly because of definitional and classification differences between the annual survey and the Census. In order to avoid the recurrence of this situation, every effort will be made to establish uniform definitions and classification procedures for the 1971 Census and future census programs.

La présente publication se rapporte à l'année 1966 et résume les résultats de la dix-huitième enquête annuelle consécutive sur l'hôtellerie au Canada. La Section I comporte les données de base recueillies auprès de tous les hôtels et s'intitule "Statistiques principales". A la Section II, on trouvera certains éléments de dépense fournis par les hôtels de taille moyenne (de 11 à 75 chambres inclusivement), en termes de pourcentage par rapport à l'ensemble des recettes. La Section III, fournit une ventilation détaillée des dépenses des grands hôtels (76 chambres ou plus), classées en dépenses particulières et en frais généraux et exprimées sous forme de rapports.

Pour l'interprétation des chiffres présentés ici, le lecteur voudra bien tenir compte des points suivants: 1) ce bulletin ne comprend que les établissements qui correspondent aux définitions mentionnées à la page précédente, et n'inclut pas les camps, motels, cabines ni autres types de logement pour touristes; 2) les taux de dépenses des Sections II et III ne peuvent être comparés directement à ceux des années antérieures à 1956. Dès 1956, en effet, pour la Section II, tous les grands hôtels (100 chambres ou plus - 76 chambres à partir de 1965), et tous les hôtels ayant 10 chambres ou moins, ont été exclus de cette partie de l'enquête.

Il y a également lieu de noter que les données se rapportant à la couverture, aux revenus et aux dépenses qui figurent ici ne sont pas strictement comparables à celles qui avaient paru à l'occasion du recensement du commerce et des services de 1966. Des variations existent surtout en raison des différences de définitions et de classement entre l'enquête annuelle et le recensement. Pour éviter le retour d'une situation semblable, tout sera mis en oeuvre afin d'établir des définitions et des méthodes de classement uniformes valables pour le recensement de 1971 et pour les programmes de recensement à venir.

SECTION I

Principal Statistics

The number of hotels known to be operating in Canada in 1966 totalled 4,685 as compared with 4,846 in 1965, a decrease of 161. These hotels contained 153,074 rooms with 116,686 single beds and 97,790 double beds. Total receipts for 1966 amounted to \$790,543,000 as compared with \$740,031,000 for 1965, an increase of 6.8 per cent. The sale of beer, wine and liquor accounted for 47.7 per cent of total receipts, followed by room rentals (24.0 per cent), meals (21.3 per cent) and other sources (7.0 per cent). The 1966 percentages show slight increases in the proportion of total receipts accounted for by room rentals (23.4 per cent in 1965) and sales of meals (21.1 per cent in 1965) while the proportion of total receipts accounted for by the sales of beer, wine and liquor in 1966 declined marginally when compared to the 1965 percentage of 48.6. Employment in hotels was made up of 71,954 persons during 1966, including 40,468 male and 31,486 female employees. Salaries and wages paid during 1966 reached a level of \$198,035,000 a gain of 7.1 per cent over the 1965 figure of \$184,956,000.

With improvements in the reporting form it has been possible to be more precise in the classification of businesses reporting to the hotel survey. As previously indicated, the net change in the hotel "universe" between 1965 and 1966 was a decrease of 161 hotels. This decline was due principally to the elimination of certain hotels which were included in 1965 but which failed to meet the definition requirements for 1966: tourist homes, motels, cabins, taverns, restaurants, hotels mainly catering to permanent guests and other types of businesses. Hotels which closed during the year, changed the nature of their operation, were destroyed by fires, etc., were also excluded. However, the 1966 total includes all known new hotels which opened during this period and which met definitional requirements.

Of the 4,685 hotels known to be in operation in Canada during 1966, the number of full-year licensed hotels (licensed to sell alcoholic beverages) totalled 3,865 and their receipts amounted to \$750,920,000. In 1965, the total was 3,953 hotels with receipts of \$701,855,000. There were 327 full-year non-licensed hotels with receipts of \$13,518,000 in 1966, compared with 360 hotels and receipts of \$13,549,000 during the previous year. Seasonal licensed hotels numbered 166 (179 in 1965) with receipts of \$17,590,000 (\$16,397,000 in 1965), and 327 operated as seasonal non-licensed with receipts of \$8,515,000 as against 354 in 1965 with receipts of \$8,235,000.

The distribution of hotel receipts by room categories is shown in Table 6. Hotels with between 11-25 rooms continued to be most numerous. These numbered 2,033 in 1966 reporting receipts of \$163,065,000 compared with 2,079 in 1965 with receipts of \$157,722,000. This group was followed by hotels with 26-50 rooms of which there were 1,062 in 1966 with receipts of \$181,951,000 as against 1,104 in 1965 with receipts totalling \$171,981,000. Percentages of room occupancy for all hotels having 11 or more rooms will be found in Table 8. These percentages are not comparable to those calculated prior to 1956 due to the inclusion in former years of hotels in the 10 rooms or less category. For 1966 the national average was 57 per cent which equalled the rate for the previous year. The room occupancy rate increased as the size of hotel increased, going from 43 per cent for hotels within the 11-25 rooms group size to 66 per cent for those in the 201 or more rooms group size.

Throughout this report, room receipts include sample rooms and public space rentals. Receipts from all other sources include non-operative revenue such as commercial rentals, leased concessions, interest on investments, etc. These and other statistics are given in greater detail in the tables that follow.

Statistiques principales

Le nombre des hôtels dont on sait qu'ils ont été exploités en 1966 au Canada était de 4,685, au lieu de 4,846 en 1965, ce qui constitue une diminution de 161. Ces hôtels comportaient 153,074 chambres, pour 116,686 lits simples et 97,790 lits doubles. En 1966, les recettes totales se montaient à \$790,543,000 contre \$740,031,000 en 1965, soit une augmentation de 6.8 p. 100. La vente de bière, de vin et de spiritueux représentait 47.7 p. 100 de l'ensemble des recettes, suivie par la location de chambres (24.0 p. 100), les repas (21.3 p. 100) et les revenus d'autres sources (7.0 p. 100). Les taux de 1966 font ressortir de légères augmentations en ce qui concerne la part des recettes globales représentée par la location de chambres (23.4 p. 100 en 1965), et par la vente de repas (21.1 p. 100 en 1965), alors que la part prise par la vente de bière, de vin et de spiritueux a diminué dans une proportion minime par rapport au taux de 48.6 p. 100 valable pour 1965. Les effectifs employés dans l'hôtellerie en 1966 se composaient de 71,954 personnes, dont 40,468 hommes et 31,486 femmes. Les rémunérations versées en 1966 atteignaient \$198,035,000 et avaient augmenté de 7.1 p. 100 par rapport aux \$184,956,000 valables pour 1965.

Les améliorations apportées au questionnaire ont permis d'obtenir une plus grande précision dans le classement des entreprises déclarantes de l'enquête sur l'hôtellerie. Comme il a déjà été dit, la variation nette subie par "l'univers" des hôtels de 1965 à 1966 s'est traduite par une diminution de 161 hôtels. Cette diminution provenait surtout de l'élimination de certains hôtels qui avaient été inclus en 1965, mais qui ne répondent plus aux définitions édictées pour 1966, à savoir: les logis pour touristes, motels, cabines, tavernes, restaurants, hôtels dont les services sont surtout réservés à des pensionnaires permanents et à des entreprises d'autre type. Les hôtels qui, au cours de l'année, ont été fermés, ont modifié la nature de leur exploitation, ont été détruits par le feu, etc. ont également été exclus. Par contre, le total pour 1966 comprend tous les hôtels neufs dont l'existence est connue ayant ouvert en cours d'année et répondant aux définitions.

Sur les 4,685 hôtels dont on sait qu'ils ont été exploités en 1966, 3,865 étaient des établissements autorisés (pour la vente de boissons alcooliques) ouverts toute l'année, et leurs recettes atteignaient \$750,920,000. En 1965, ce total avait été de 3,953 hôtels, pour des recettes de \$701,855,000. En 1966, il existait 327 hôtels non autorisés ouverts toute l'année, pour des recettes de \$13,518,000 contre 360 hôtels et \$13,549,000 l'année précédente. Les hôtels autorisés saisonniers étaient au nombre de 166 (179 en 1965), leurs recettes étant de \$17,590,000 (\$16,397,000 en 1965), alors que 327 établissements non autorisés saisonniers avaient des recettes de \$8,515,000 contre 354 en 1965, pour des recettes de \$8,235,000.

La ventilation des recettes hôtelières d'après les chambres figure au Tableau 6. Les hôtels comportant de 11 à 25 chambres ont continué à être les plus nombreux. Leur nombre s'établissait à 2,033 en 1966, pour des recettes déclarées de \$163,065,000 au lieu de 2,079 en 1965, pour des recettes d'un montant de \$157,722,000. Le groupe suivant était constitué par les hôtels comportant de 26 à 50 chambres, au nombre de 1,062 en 1966, pour des recettes de \$181,951,000 au lieu de 1,104 en 1965, pour des recettes totales de \$171,981,000. Les taux d'occupation des chambres pour tous les hôtels comportant au moins 11 chambres figurent au tableau 8. Ces pourcentages ne sauraient être comparés à ceux qui avaient été établis avant 1956, du fait que l'on inclutait autrefois les hôtels de 10 chambres ou moins. En 1966, le taux moyen valable pour l'ensemble du Canada était de 57 p. 100, c'est-à-dire le même que l'année précédente. Le taux d'occupation des chambres s'est accru en raison directe de l'accroissement de la taille des hôtels, variant de 43 p. 100 pour les hôtels ayant de 11 à 25 chambres, à 66 p. 100 pour les hôtels ayant 201 chambres ou plus.

Dans toute cette publication, les recettes se rapportant aux chambres comprennent les produits de la location de salles d'exposition et de locaux au public. Les recettes provenant de toute autre source comprennent les revenus étrangers à l'exploitation, tels que les locations de caractère commercial, les concessions à bail, l'intérêt sur les placements, etc. Ces statistiques ainsi que d'autres figurent avec plus de détail aux tableaux ci-après.



SECTION II

Salaries and Wages, Cost of Goods and
Certain Occupancy Expenses

Table II shows salaries and wages, cost of goods sold, cost of light, heat and power, and repairs and maintenance expressed as percentages of total receipts for incorporated and unincorporated hotels. These percentages are based on the reports of a panel of hotels with between 11 and 75 rooms inclusive and do not represent total coverage of hotels in this category. The only item of expense obtained for all hotels is that of salaries and wages shown in Section I of this report.

The reader is again reminded that the ratios contained in the following table are not comparable to those of years prior to 1956 because of the exclusion since then of all hotels in the 10 rooms or less and 100 or more categories (76 or more since 1965). Except for salaries and wages, ratios for unincorporated hotels were usually slightly higher than those for incorporated hotels. The cost of goods sold, as a percentage of total receipts, constituted the greatest expense item in both categories (42.8 per cent for incorporated and 47.5 per cent for unincorporated).

Rémunérances et salaires, coût des marchandises vendues et certains frais d'exploitation

Le Tableau II indique les rémunérations, le coût des marchandises vendues, le coût d'éclairage, de chauffage et d'énergie, ainsi que les réparations et l'entretien, en termes de pourcentages par rapport aux recettes totales des hôtels constitués ou non. Ces taux sont fondés sur les déclarations d'un groupe déterminé constitué par des hôtels ayant de 11 à 75 chambres inclusivement et ne portent pas sur le total des hôtels de cette catégorie. Le seul élément de dépenses qui ait été fourni par l'ensemble intégral des hôtels porte sur les rémunérations mentionnées à la section I de la présente publication.

Le lecteur voudra bien se rappeler à nouveau que les rapports qui figurent au tableau ci-après ne sauraient être comparés à ceux établis avant 1956, du fait que l'on a, depuis lors, exclus tous les hôtels ayant 10 chambres ou moins et 100 chambres ou plus (76 ou plus, depuis 1965). Sauf pour ce qui est des traitements et salaires, l'ordre de grandeur des rapports valables pour les hôtels non constitués était, en général, plus grand que pour les hôtels constitués en société. Le coût des marchandises vendues exprimé en pourcentage par rapport à l'ensemble des recettes, constituait l'élément de dépense le plus important dans les deux catégories (42.8 p. 100 pour les hôtels constitués, et 47.5 p. 100 pour les hôtels non constitués).

SECTION III

Departmental and General Expense Ratios

This section presents data relating to receipts and operating expenses and is restricted to incorporated hotels with 76 rooms or more which were open for the entire year and able to supply the detailed statistics requested. These hotels were divided into two groups: Licensed hotels (licensed to sell alcoholic beverages) operating their own dining room and licensed hotels not operating their own dining room. Tables 12 and 13 show these operating expenses as percentages of total receipts and classified into departmental and general expenses. Departmental expenses are shown as a percentage of receipts of the department as well as of total receipts. Information on profit, room occupancy, room rates and tental revenue is also given.

Rapports des dépenses particulières et des frais généraux

Dans cette section figurent des données se rapportant aux recettes et aux dépenses d'exploitation, exclusivement en ce qui concerne les hôtels constitués ayant au moins 76 chambres, restés ouverts toute l'année, et en mesure de fournir la statistique détaillée qui était demandée. Ces hôtels ont été classés en deux groupes: les hôtels autorisés (à vendre des boissons alcooliques) exploitant leur propre salle à manger, et les hôtels autorisés n'exploitant pas leur propre salle à manger. Ces dépenses d'exploitation figurent aux tableaux 12 et 13, exprimées en pourcentages par rapport à l'ensemble des recettes, et sont classées par dépenses particulières et frais généraux. Les dépenses particulières sont indiquées en pourcentages par rapport aux recettes du service auxquelles elles se rapportent ainsi que par rapport à l'ensemble des recettes. On a également indiqué des renseignements concernant les bénéfices, le taux d'occupation des chambres, les prix des chambres et les revenus de location.
