## BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, APRIL, 1940.

The April roport of building permits issuod by munioipalitios in Canada is presented herewith and includes returns from 175 municipelities, 25 more than we showed in our March report. Of this number, 164 reported dotalled permits, while the romaining 11 advised that none had been issued by them during that month. 27 municipalitios failed to report. The total value of permits reported to us as having beon issued in the month of April is $\$ 9,916,639$. Revised values for the month of Maroh now show permits from 197 municipelities, valued at $\$ 5,584,166$ 。

Of the 58 original munioipalities, 57 reported a value of $\$ 6,959,537$ for the month of April. The revised value for the total 58 for the month of Maroh amounts to $\$ 4,535,791$. The oorrespouding value for April 1939 was $\$ 5,960,638$.

The total value of permits issuod during the first 4 months by all munioipalitios is $\$ 22,756,183$, and the rovised value for the 58 munioipalities is $\$ 16,981,166$. The oorresponding value for the 58 in 1939 was $\$ 12,953,605$.

New oonstruotion of all types amounted to 72.9 per oent of the total value and the perontage of new residential construction was 51.4 .

An aocurate and authentio index value for the 202 munioipalitios oan only be arrived at from values covering a 12 month period. Therefore, this index will not be available until 1941.
