

## BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, JULY, 1940.

The July report of Building Permits includes returns from 162 of the 203 munioipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 151 reported detailed operations. The remaining 11 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of July while 41 municipalities had failed to report at the olose of August loth.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of July is $\$ 10,497,006$. Revised values for the month of June include returns from 190 municipalities and aggregate $\$ 9,769,503$. Reports were received fram 50 of the original 58 municipalities and show a value of $\$ 7,874,638$ for the last month. The corresponding revised value for June includes 56 returns and is $\$ 7,355,671$, while the June 1939 value was $\$ 6,584,125$.

The total value of permits issued by all munioipalities during the seven elapsed months of the ourrent yoar is $\$ 57,798,471$. The value for the 58 munioipalities for the same period is $\$ 42,247,633$, while their corresponding value in 1939 was $\$ 33,647,625$.

During the month of July new construction of all types amounted to 77.5 percent of the total value, while the peroentage of new residential construotion was 39.2.
