BUILDING PERATK TEPOAT FOM LITY, 1925, IITH COISPLPAIIVE STATGUENTS FOR AFSII, 1225 , NDD MAY, 1924.

There was a slight increase in the value of the building permits issued in 60 cities during was as compared with Ciril, 1925, and the total was also higher thon in the same month of last year, which is tha more significani comparison. The building authorized was vilued at $\$ 15,296,080$ during the nonth under reviev; this was 3253,561 or 1.7 p.c. higher than the April, 1925, agcregate of $15,042,519$, and 674,980 or 4.6 p .c. above the total for liay, 1224, of $914,621,100$.

Some 50 cities furnished cotailod statemonts showing that thoy issued noarly 1,700 pormits for dzollings estimetoc to cost ovor $7,000,000$ and about 3,200 poimits for othor buildings at a proposer cost of more than $\% 6,600,000$.

Ontario, Scskatcho:ran, Alberta and Eritish Colurabia roportod incroesos in the valuo of the brilding pormits issuod as compared with hpril, 1925. Tho gain of $\mathbf{~} 334,637$, or $105.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. , in Saskatchoran and of $\mathbf{~} 1,107,709$, or $15.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in Ontario yoro wost pronouncod. Of tho doclinos in tho romining provinces, those of 5550,209 , or $85.5 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c} . \mathrm{C}$ in Nova Scotic and of 394,720 or 90.1 p .0 . in Now Brunswick woro largast.

As comparod with May, 1924, Move Scotia, Ontario, IIanitoba and British Volumbia recorlod improvomont. Tho srontost incroaso of $2,363,240$, or 40.2 p.c. :zas in Ontriic, ilthough Nova Scotia shoved tho groatost proportional gain of : 30,160 , or $47.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. In tho other provinces thero woro roductions, of which ilborta roportud tho most ins rkod. In that province, thero was a loss of $1,175,725$, or $71.1 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$. during the month undor roviow; tho total for iday, 1924, was oxcoptionally high, owing to a pornit having been issuud ios tho construction of a Dominion govomment grain olovator at Edmoricon.

In Nontroal and ifinnipeg, thuro vore docroases in the valuo of the building cuthorized as comparod with ippril, 1925, and ily, 1924; Towonto showod iaprovoment in boih comprrisons, while in Vancouvor the towil was lover then in the procoding wenth, but hiohor then in tho samo :2onth of lest yorr. Nour Glasgou, Frodoricton, Shawinigen Falis, Chathar, iliagare Palls, Ottwre, Owon Soum, Port Arihur, St. Thoms, Sarnic, Wollone, Ford, Sandwich, St. Bonifaco, Rogina, Princo Rupert and South Vancouver registored lorge abcrogntos of pormits issucd then in oithor ipril, 1925, or 15y, 1824.

The value of the building permits issued in the first five months of this year was $\mathbf{~} 50,011,236$, as compared with $34,890,525$ in the samo periou of 1924, 557,852,503 in 1523, 53,518,812 in 1922, 24, 320,556 in 1921 and 47,574,581 in 1920. Thero was, thercfore, an inceouse of $9.0 \mathrm{p.c}$. as co.marod with 1924, a Cocroaso oi 13.6 p.c. as comparod witil 1923 and $0 \hat{i} 7.2$, c.c. 2 . compared with 1922 , and incroases of 21.0 p.c. and 5.1 p.c. as comparod with 1921 and 192 , rospeatively. Tho Bureau's weichted index number of wholosale pricos oí building rabrinlsavoragod 154.1 during the first five nonths of this year, as comparod ith $166.0,165.7$. 166.1, 200.9 and 215.9 in 1924, 1923, 1922, 1921 and 1920, rospectivoly.
