BUILDING PERIITM REPORT FOR DECEMBER, 1926, WITH COMPARATIVE STATEAENTS FOR YOVENBER, 1926, ATID こقuE:II, 1925; AND CUMULITIVE FIGRES FOR YEARS 1920-26.

The value of the building permits issued by 63 cities in December, 1926, was the highest for that month since this record was begun in 1920, there being authorizations valued at $\$ 11,472,131$. This was an increase of 15.1 p.c. over the November total of $\$ 9,968.937$ and of 55.8 p.c. as compared with the aggregate of $\$ 7,363,777$ in December, 1925.

Detailed statements were received from some fifty cities, showing that they had issued over 500 permits for dwelinge valued at almost $\$ 3,300,000$ and nearly 900 permits for other buildings at an estimated cost of approximately $\$ 7,000,000$. During November, the construction was authorized of over 1,000 dwellings and 2,000 other buildings, ostimated to cost nearly $\$ 5,300,000$ and $\$ 4,200,000$, respectively.

As conpared with the preceding month, Quebec registered an increase of $\$ 4,054,818$ or 134.7 p.c. in the value of the building permits issued. Of the declines in the remaining rrovinces, those of $\$ 2,096,930$ or 39.1 p.c. in Ontario and $\$ 172,990$ or 84.3 P.C. in Manitoba were the largest.

As compared with December; 1925, Quebec, Alberta and British Columbia recorded increases in the value of building authorized, Quebec again showing the most marked gain of $\$ 4,882,070^{\circ}$ or 223.6 p.c. The other provinces reported reductions in the value of building authorized, that in ontario of $\$ 910,650$, or 21.8 p.c., being the largest.

Montreal registered an important increase in the building permits issued; the December total mas the greatest registered in any month of 1926 and "mas also larger than in Decombor of any otrer year since 1910. Toronto, Tinnipeg and Vancauver roported doclines as compared. with the preceding month and also as compared...ith the same month in 1925. Otさama, Tindsor, Kamlonps, Nem Testminster and Prince Rupert recorded increases in both comparisons.

## CUMULARIVE RECORD FOR 1226.

The folloming table gives the value of the building authorized by 63 oitios during the month of December, 1926, and also in the twelve months of each year since 1920; the 1926 figures are unrayisod, while for the preceding years the statistics are revised. The average index mumbers of wholesale prices of building materials for those yuars are also given $(1913=100)$.


The Jocember total for the 63 cities was the highest in the record, as shomn aboye, while for the 35 cities it mas higher than in any other year of the record, except 1912, when the total ress $\$ 12,450,215$.

Unrevised statistics for 1926 show that the last year's ageregatc mas greator than in any other of the six preceding years, exceeding the previous high level in 1922 by 5.5 p.c. The tmoive months' total for the 35 citics was exceedod only three times, in 1917, 1912 and 1913, since the record was wegun in 1910.
