## BUILDIMG PERMITS REPORTS FOR JANUARY, 193H, WITH COIPARNTIVE

ST, TTEMENIS FOR DECEMBER, 1933, NTD JMNUARY, 1933.
There was a seasonal decline in the value of tho building permits issucd by 61 cities during Jamary as compared with tho proceding month, and the total was also lower than in Jamury, 1933; the comoperating municipalitics reported permits for buildings est imat do cost $\$ 693,962$, compared with \$1,983,2921/ in Decembor, 1933, and \$1,185,9611/ in Jonuary of last yoar. There mas, therofore, a roduction of $65.0 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in the first and of $41.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in the socond comparison.

Somo 50 cities furnishod detailece statcmonts, showing that thoy had granted some 40 permits for dwollings valued at about $\$ 136,000$, and about 460 pormits for othor buildings ost imated to cost approximatoly $\$ 480,000$. In Docombor, authority węs grant ed for the eroction of some 60 drellings and 400 othor buildings, ost imated to cost approximat ely $\$ 305,000$ and $\$ 1,500,000$, respectivciy.

Nova Scotia, Alberta and British Columbia roport od increasos in the value of the building authorizod during Jamary as comparod. aith Docombor, 1933 , the gain of $\$ 26,628$ or 61.0 p.c. in British Columbia being most noterorthy. Of tho doelines olsewhero recorded, that of $\$ 747,635$, or 89.2 p.c. in Quoboc Was groatcost.

As comparcd with Jamuary, 1933, Now Brunswick and Ontario showod increases of 22.7 p.c. and 29.4 p.c. respectively. Roductions worc roport od in the remaining provincos, that of $\$ 243,476$ or $98.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. in Saskat chowan boing most pronounced.

In Montroal Winnipeg, thero were decreases in tho valuc of tho building pomits grant cd as ccomparod with either the procoding month or tho samo month of last ycar; in Toronto, thore was a docline in the formor but an increnso in the latter comparison, milo in Vancouver, the $J$ anuary total was higher than in Docombor, but lower than in Jomurry, 1933. The following cities report od increasos in both comparisonsMoncton, Saint John, Three Rivers, Chatham, Fort Tillian, Galt, Kingston, Kitchener, Ottama, Poterborough, Port irthur, St. Catharines, St. Boniface, Edmonton, Medicinc Fat, Kamloops, Prince Rupert and North Vancouver.
