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# BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, AUGUST, 1941

The August report of Building Permits includes returns from 174 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 169 reported detailed operations. The remaining 5 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of August while 30 municipalities had failed to report at the close of September 10th.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of August is \$12,134,018. Revised values for the month of July include returns from 200 municipalities and aggregate \$12,904,437. Reports were received from 56 of the original 58 municipalities and show a value of \$9,394,353 for August. The corresponding revised value for July includes 58 returns and is \$9,610,473, while the August value was \$7,705,592.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the eight elapsed months of the current year is \$88,695,678. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is \$67,466,152, while their corresponding value in 1940 was \$51,545,137.

During the month of August new construction of all types amounted to 79.0 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 44.3.
