The Novemher report of Building Permits includes returns from 164 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for 1 ssuing such permits and of this number 136 reported detailed operations. The remaining 28 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of November, while 40 manicipalities had failed to report at the close of December 12th.

The total value of permis reported as issued in the month of November is $\$ 7,624,195$. Revised values for the month of October include returns from 202 municipalities and aggregate $\$ 8,432,251$. Reports were recelved from 57 of the 58 original nomicipalities and sluw a value of $\$ 5,485,935$ for November. The corresponding revised value for October, includes 58 returns and is $\$ 6,277,620$, while the November 1941, value was \$8,5?5,989.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the mleven elapsed months of the current year is $\$ 97,257,153$. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is $\$ 70,237,650$, while their corresponding value in 1941 was $\$ 94,469,739$.

During the month of Novemher new construction of all types amounted to 74.9 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 34.3.
