BUIUDDPG PRRMITS ISSULED DI DECREBER, 2946
Building pormite isavod by melcipelities whioh roported to the Dominion Buremu of statistion reaohed the value of $\$ 13,540,946$ in Doomber, recording a deoline from the November total of $\$ 18,116,256$ but exoeeding the Deoember 1944 total of $47,901,591$ by 71 por cont. Pornite for now construction were iseum in Deomber to the wive of $\$ 10,355,789$ and additicas, Elteratico and repairs, $\$ 3,205,157$. For the ourrent yoar, peraitg wore grented to the vilue of $\$ 195,142,798$ as ocmparted with $\$ 128,728,465$ in tho ocmpareble poriod of 2944 an edrunce of 52 per oent.

Now housing unite roprosented in the building permits issued in Deomber by the reporting munioipelitios numbered 1,507 of which 2,357 were now buildinge and 170 were conversions. In Deoomber lata yoar, 896 pertits were isnued for housing units, including 755 for the oonetruction of nev buildings and l41 for oonversions. The agregte

Permite for the construoticn of 28,462 new dwolling unite were grantod durlag the prosent yoar as ocmpared Fith 28,695 in the sam period of 1944. The permite for 1945 included 25,530 for new buildinge med 2,882 converniens. The value of now residential buildings, and additions and repairs thereto amountod to $1116,710,965$ during this year as sompreded with $\$ 82,951,187$ in the sam per 100 of 1944.

Tho prosent report is besed an returus received fram 166 of the 204 manioipalities in Gugade which have syatoma for 1 ssuing woh permits and of this number 135 reported detailed operntions. The romining 30 advined that no pernits had beea issued during the month. While 59 muioipalities had failed to report by danuery 12 , at whioh tim oampiletions are prooested with.
