## BUILDING PERMITS ISSURD IN CAKADA, FRBRUARY, 1245.

The February report of Building Permits included returns from 174 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 131 reported detalled operations. The remaining 43 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of February, wile 30 municipalities had falled to report at the close of March loth.

The total value of permits reported as iseued in the month of February is $\$ 7,131,923$. Revised values for the month of January include return from 200 munlcipalities and aggregate $\$ 5,391,02 \%$. Reports were received from 53 of the 58 original municipalities and show a value of $\$ 5,452,244$ for February. The corresponding revised value of Janmary includes 5 ? returns and is $\$ 4,332,95$ ? while the February 1944 value was $\$ 4,021,453$.

The total value of permits iesued by all municipalities during the two elapsed months of this year is $\$ 12,522,950$. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is $\$ 9.785,201$, while their corresponding value in 1944 พав $\$ 8,349,078$.

During the month of February new construction of all types amounted to 59.2 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential conatruction war 38.3 .

Table Nio. 4 is arranged so as to give complete information as to the number and description of now housing units (new building and conversions).
