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**OTTAWA**



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BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1945.

The February report of Building Permits included returns from 174 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 131 reported detailed operations. The remaining 43 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of February, while 30 municipalities had failed to report at the close of March 10th.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of February is \$7,131,923. Revised values for the month of January include returns from 200 municipalities and aggregate \$5,391,027. Reports were received from 53 of the 58 original municipalities and show a value of \$5,452,244 for February. The corresponding revised value of January includes 57 returns and is \$4,332,957 while the February 1944 value was \$4,021,453.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the two elapsed months of this year is \$12,522,950. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is \$9,785,201, while their corresponding value in 1944 was \$8,349,078.

During the month of February new construction of all types amounted to 59.2 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 38.3.

Table No. 4 is arranged so as to give complete information as to the number and description of new housing units (new building and conversions).
