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BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, APRIL, 1945

The April report of Building Permits included returns from 169 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 162 reported detailed operations. The remaining 7 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of April, while 35 municipalities had failed to report at the close of May 10th.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of April is \$17,352,020. Revised values for the month of March include returns from 200 municipalities and aggregate \$12,786,815. Reports were received from 55 of the 58 original municipalities and show a value of \$12,585,674 for April. The corresponding revised value of March includes 58 returns and is \$7,638,784 while the April 1944 value was \$10,458,427.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the four elapsed months of this year is \$42,750,001. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is \$30,038,790, while their corresponding value in 1944 was \$23,886,390.

During the month of April new construction of all types amounted to 77.8 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 53.5.

Table No. 4 is arranged so as to give complete information as to the number and description of new housing units (new building and conversions).
