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BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, MAY, 1945

The May report of Building Permits includes returns from 179 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 174 reported detailed operations. The remaining 5 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of May, while 25 municipalities had failed to report at the close of June 10th.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of May is \$17,348,058. Revised values for the month of April include returns from 195 municipalities and aggregate \$17,735,330. Reports were received from 57 of the 58 original municipalities and show a value of \$12,434,770 for May. The corresponding revised value of April includes 57 returns and is \$12,607,374 while the May 1944 value was \$12,822,599.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the five elapsed months of this year is \$60,481,369. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is \$42,495,260, while their corresponding value in 1944 was \$36,708,989.

During the month of May new construction of all types amounted to 82.3 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 69.9.

Table No. 4 is arranged so as to give complete information as to the number and description of new housing units (new building and conversions).
