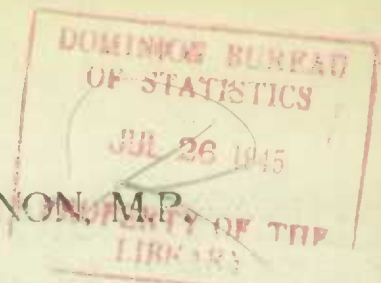

BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN CANADA, JUNE, 1945

The June report of Building Permits includes returns from 174 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and of this number 168 reported detailed operations. The remaining 6 advised that no permits had been issued during the month of June, while 30 municipalities had failed to report at the close of July 10th.

The total value of permits reported as issued in the month of June is \$17,189,891. Revised values for the month of May include returns from 196 municipalities and aggregate \$17,778,173. Reports were received from 55 of the 58 original municipalities and show a value of \$12,396,752 for June. The corresponding revised value of May includes 58 returns and is \$12,530,755 while the June 1944 value was \$10,871,193.

The total value of permits issued by all municipalities during the six elapsed months of this year is \$78,111,275. The value of the 58 municipalities for the same period is \$54,987,997, while their corresponding value in 1944 was \$47,580,182.

During the month of June new construction of all types amounted to 78.7 per cent of the total value, while the percentage of new residential construction was 61.1.

Table No. 4 is arranged so as to give complete information as to the number and description of new housing units (new building and conversions).
