## BUTLDING PBRMITS ISSUED TN JANUARY, 1946

Building pormits issued by anioipelitios whioh roportod to tho Dominion Burseu of Statistios rewohed the vilue of $\$ 13,539,919$ in January, recording docilne from the Deoomber total of $\$ 15,281,878$ but exooeding the January 1945 totel of $\$ 5,394,227$ by 162 per out. Permite for now oonstruction wore iseucd in jemuary to the Felue of $\$ 6,976,560$ and addition, alterationi and ropairi, $\$ 737,062$. For the pat yoar, pormits wore granted to the value of $\$ 196,858,255$ as oompared with $\$ 128,728,465$ in the comparable poriod of 1944 , an edvence of 53 per oent.

Now housing unit: ropresented in tho building permite iesuod in jenuery by the roporting munioipelitios rumbered 1,908 of whioh 1,658 more now buildinge and 250 wore oonverelone. In January lest year, B06 pornits were issued for houling unste. inoluding 578 for the oonstruotion of now buildinge and 228 for conversions. Tho geregate Teluo of now residontiel buildinge, additions and ropeirs theroto, wes $\$ 7,713,612$ in jenumpy this yoer as oomperod with $\$ 2,400,692$ in january. 1945.

Pormite for the conetruotion of $2 B, 55 B$ now dwaling unite were granted during last your as oompared with 23,695 in the mano period of 1944. The permite for 1945 inoluded 25,617 for now buildinge and 2,541 oonvorsions. The value of new residential buildings, and adition and repairs thereto mounted to 8117,784 , 666 during lest yoer at compared with $\$ 82,951,187$ in the semo period of 1944 .

The present report is besed on return received from 165 of the 204 munioipelitioe in canade whioh heve systom for iseuing suoh pormits and of this number 152 reported deteilod oporations. The rominims 35 advised that no permite had beon iseued during the month, while 39 muniaipalities had failed to report by Fobruary i2, at whioh timo oompilations are prooesded with.
