\text { BUILDING FERMI'SS ISSUED IN APRIL, } 1946
$$

Buildine permite issued by munieipalitios which roported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reached the value of $\$ 52,683,371$ in April, rocordine an increase from the March total of $639,567,003$ and oxcoeds the april 1945 total of $\$ 17,849,686$ by 195 per cont. Purmits for now construction were issued in April to the value of $142,328,669$ and addicions, mltorations and ropalre, $\$ 10,354,702$. For the first four monthe of the curront yoar, permits wore granted to the value of $\$ 124,086,788$ as ocmpared with $\$ 43,133,311$ in the comparable period of 1945 , an advance of 188 per oont.

Now housing units represonted in the builiing permits issued in April by the reporting municipalities numbered 6,946 of which 6,493 wors now bulldings and 455 wors conversions. "In April last your, 2,638 pormits wore istued for housing units, including 2,411 for the sonstruction of now buildings and 227 for conversions. The aggregato valuo of now residential bufldings, additions and ropairs thoroto, was $428,511,334$ in April this yoar as compared with $\$ 10,434,443$ in Apri1, 1945.

Fermits for the oonstruction of 25,606 new dwelling unite were granted during the first four monthe of tho present year as oompared with 6,285 in the same period of 1945 . The pormites for 1946 included 14, 240 for new buildinge and 1,363 sonversions. The Thlue of now rosidential buildings, and additions and ropairs thoreto amountod to $\$ 65,226,541$ during the first four months of this yoar as compared with $\$ 24,068,997$ in the same period of 1945.

The present report is basod on returns received from 185 of the 204 municipalitios in Canada which have yotems for issuing such permite and of this number 183 reported detailed operations. The remaining 1 advised that no pormite had been iesued during the menth, whilo 20 municipalitios had fallod to roport by May 12 at mhtoh timo compliations are procesded with.
