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BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED IN JUNE, 1946

Building permits issued by municipalities which reported to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reached the value of \$25,346,002 in June, recording a decrease from the May total of \$47,458,102 but exceeding the June 1945 total of \$19,566,002 by 30 per cent. Permits for new construction were issued in June to the value of \$21,190,437 and additions, alterations and repairs, \$4,155,565. For the first six months of the current year, permits were granted to the value of \$200,738,967 as compared with \$80,673,251 in the comparable period of 1945, an advance of 149 per cent.

New housing untis represented in the building permits issued in June by the reporting municipalities numbered 3,310 of which 3,085 were new buildings and 225 were conversions. In june last year, 3,036 permits were issued for housing units, including 2,816 for the construction of new buildings and 220 for conversions. The aggregate value of new residential buildings, additions and repairs thereto, was \$15,425,023 in June this year as compared with \$13,155,958 in June 1945.

Permits for the construction of 24,924 new dwelling units were granted during the first six months of the present year as compared with 12,589 in the same period of 1945. The permits for 1946 included 22,858 for new buildings and 2,066 conversions. The value of new residential buildings, and additions and repairs thereto amounted to \$103,016,584 during the first six months of this year as compared with \$51,161,037 in the same period of 1945.

The present report is based on returns received from 168 of the 204 municipalities in Canada which have systems for issuing such permits and, of this number, 166 reported detailed operations. The remaining 2 advised that no permits had been issued during the month while 36 municipalities failed to report by June 12, at which time compilations are proceeded with.
