## BUILDIWG PRFMITS ISSUED IN AUGUST, 1946

Building pernits issued by musioipulities whioh reported to the Dominion Burenu of Statistios resched the Filue of $\$ 25,759,214$ in mgust, reoording deoreaee from the July total of $854,083,984$ end exoeding the August ligk total of $\$ 23,276,789$ by 10.7 per oont. Pornite for now oonstruotion were 18 oued in August to the valuo of $20,817,788$ and additions, alterations and ropairs, $44,942.428$. For the first ight monthe of the ourrent year, permite wer grented to the Felue of $267,361,579$ ee compered with $4123,889,319$ in the compereble period of 1945 , on edvence of 116 per oent.

Hew housing units ropresexted in the building pernits iseued in dugut by the reporting munioipalities numbered 3,422 of which 3,257 were now buildinge and 265 wer oonversions. In August latet yonr, 2,746 permits wert iseued for housing unite, inoluding 2.436 for the conetruetion of now bulldinge end 312 for oonversione. Fhe efgrege to value of now residentiel buildings, additions and repairs thereto, whe $15,462,546$ in August this your an oompered with 11.524. 458 in August 1945.

Pormite for the construotion of 32,040 now dwelling units were granted during the first olght wonthe of the preaent year es compared with 18,363 in the period of 1945 . The pernite for 1946 inoluded 29 , 454 for new buildinge and 2,586 for conversions. Ih value of new residentiad buildinge, red additions end repire to +187,948,254 during the sirst oight monthe of this yoar as ocmpared with $175,728,807$ in the same period of 1945 .

The present report is bseed on returns recelved from 162 of the 204 munioipelities in Canade whioh have systone for issuing suoh permite end, of this number, 257 roported dotalled operetions. The remining 5 advised thet no permite hed been isaued during the month while 42 munioipalities failed to roport by soptember 10 , whioh time compiletions are proceeded with.
